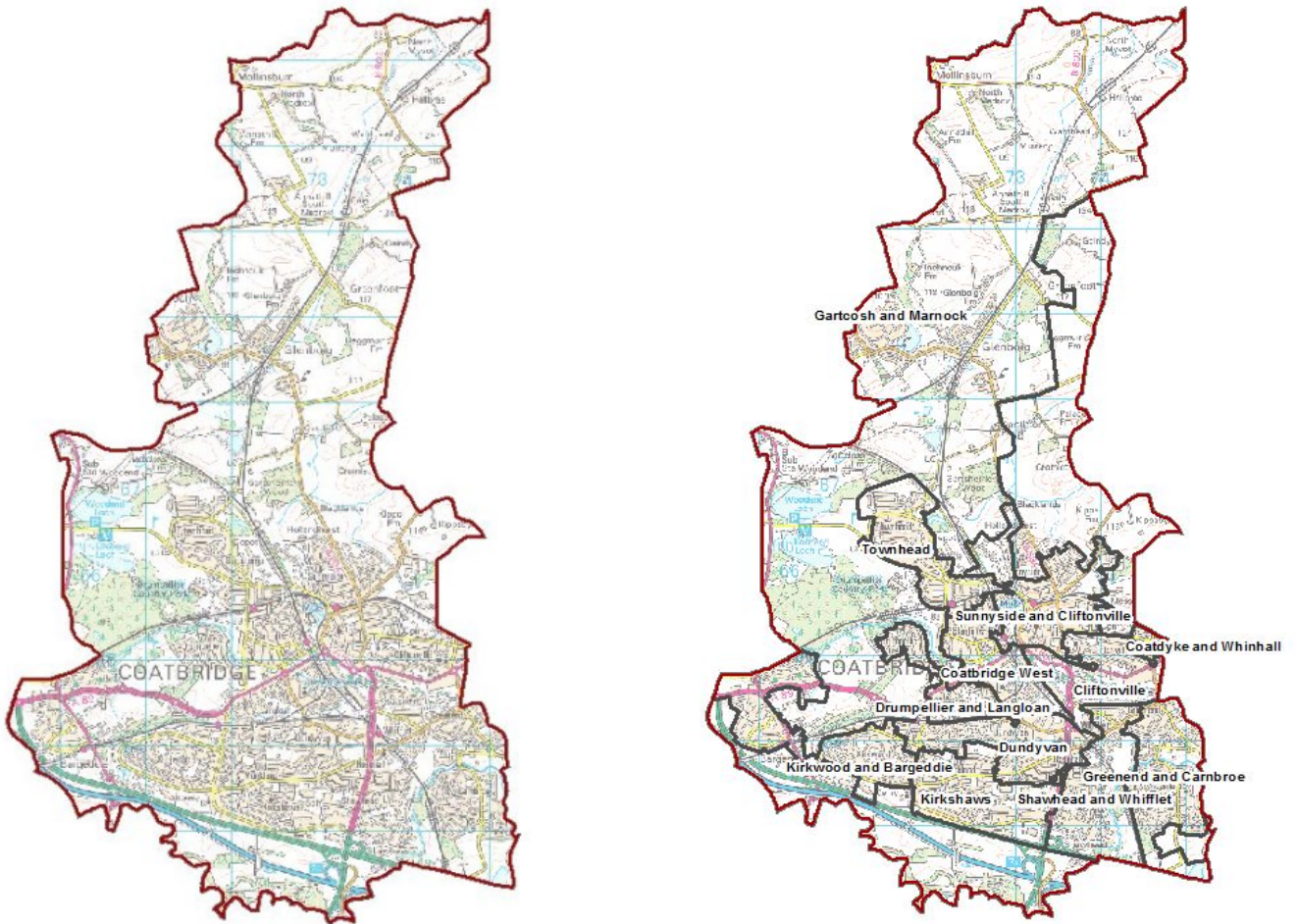


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Geography

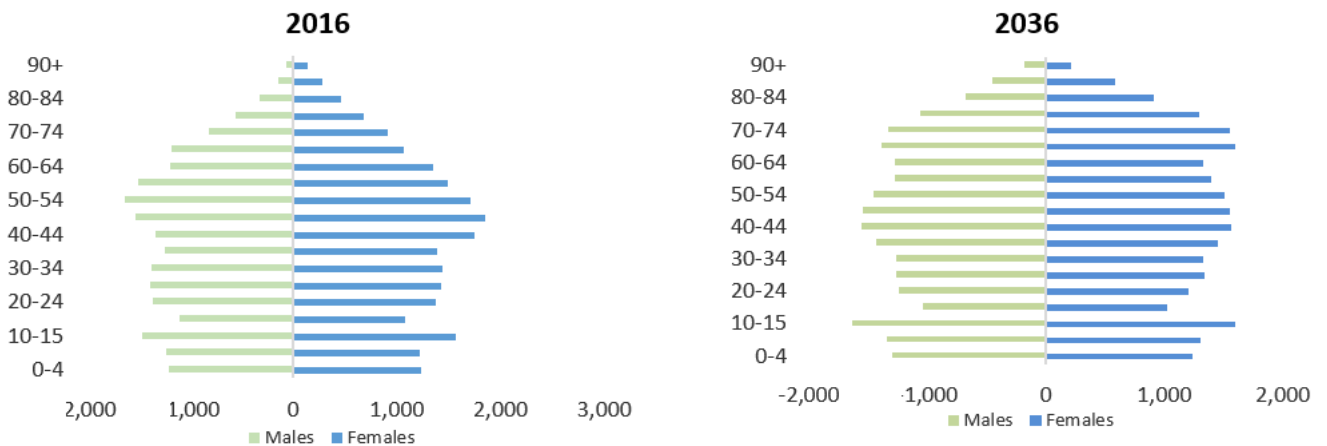

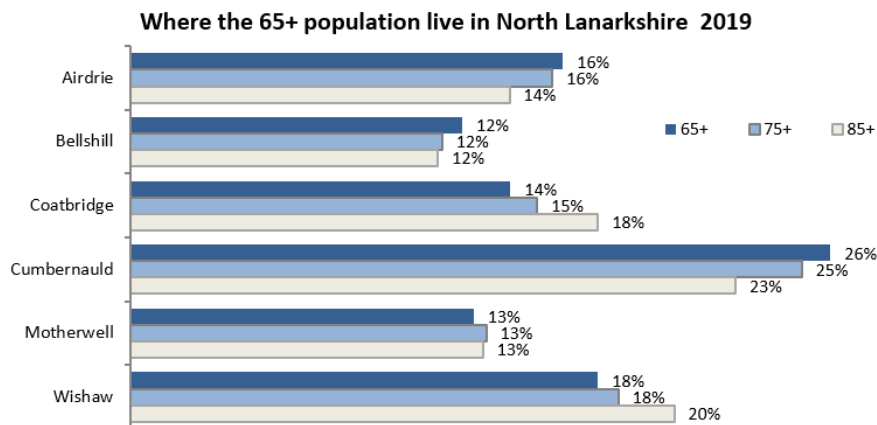

The distribution of the older population across the council is shown in the three graphs below.



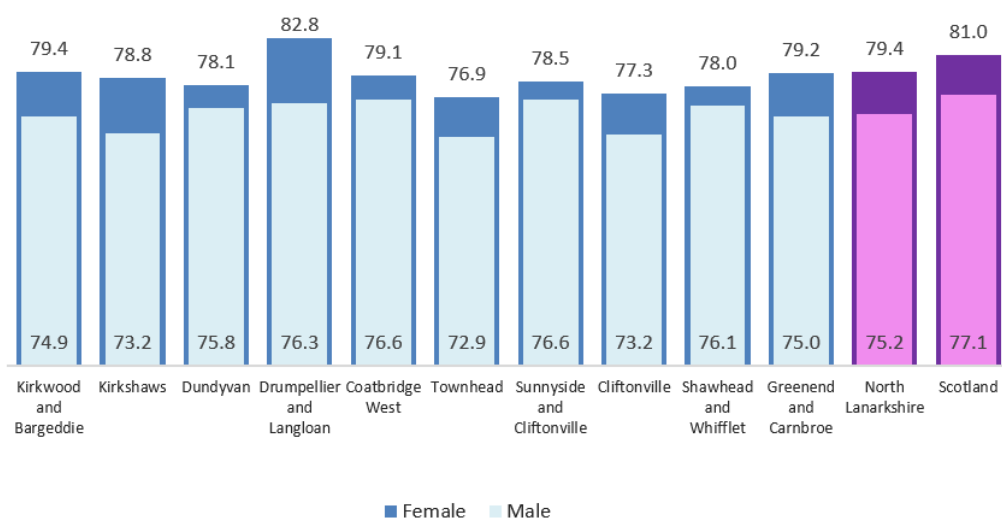

Estimated life expectancy in Coatbridge social work locality, 2016 (2014-2018 5 year aggregate)



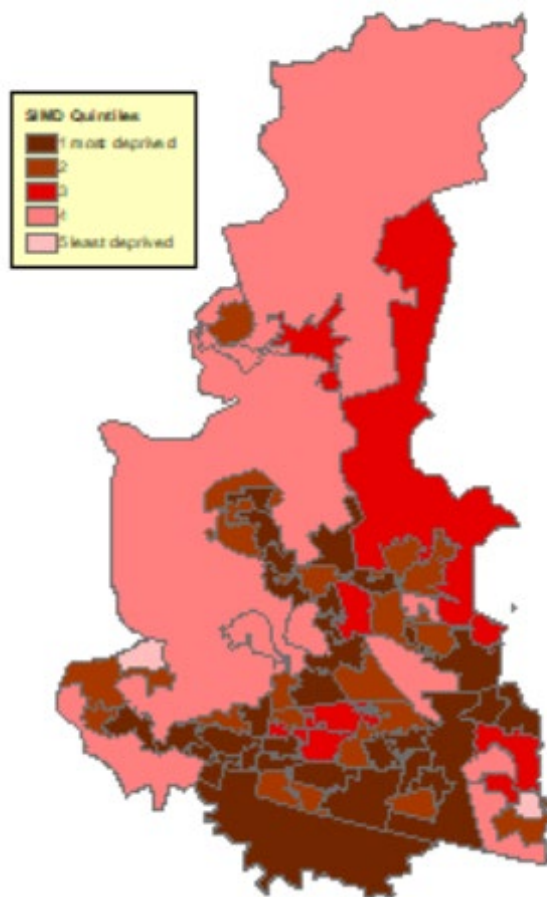
- Male life expectancy is highest in Craigneuk, Airdrie at 85.5 years and lowest in Craigneuk, Wishaw at 65.0 years
- Female life expectancy is highest in 2 areas - Balloch East and Stepps - (87.2 years) and lowest in Craigneuk, Wishaw (69.1 years).

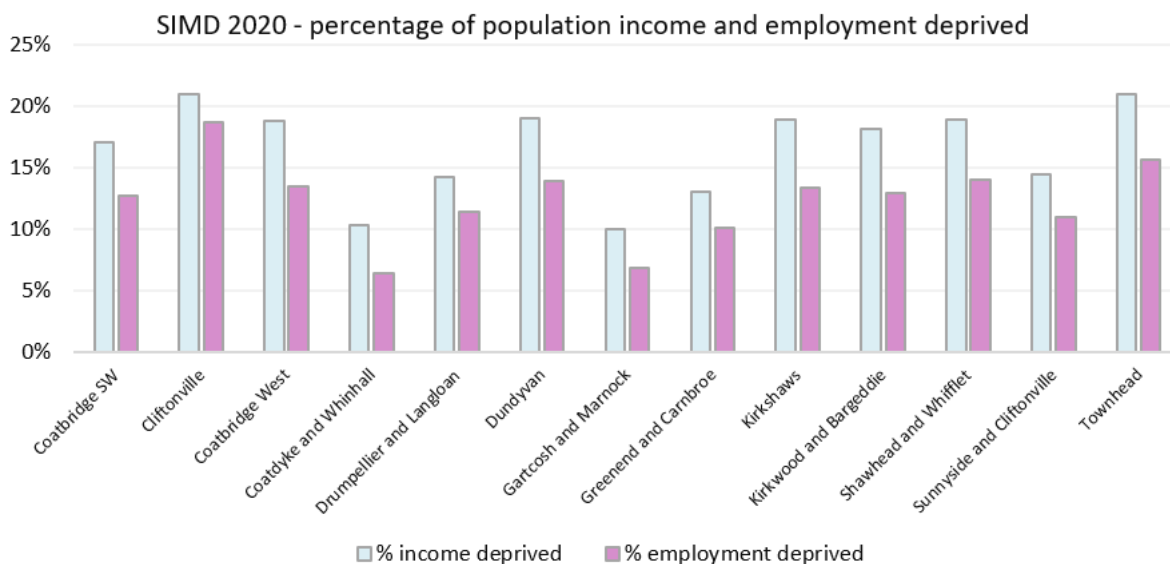

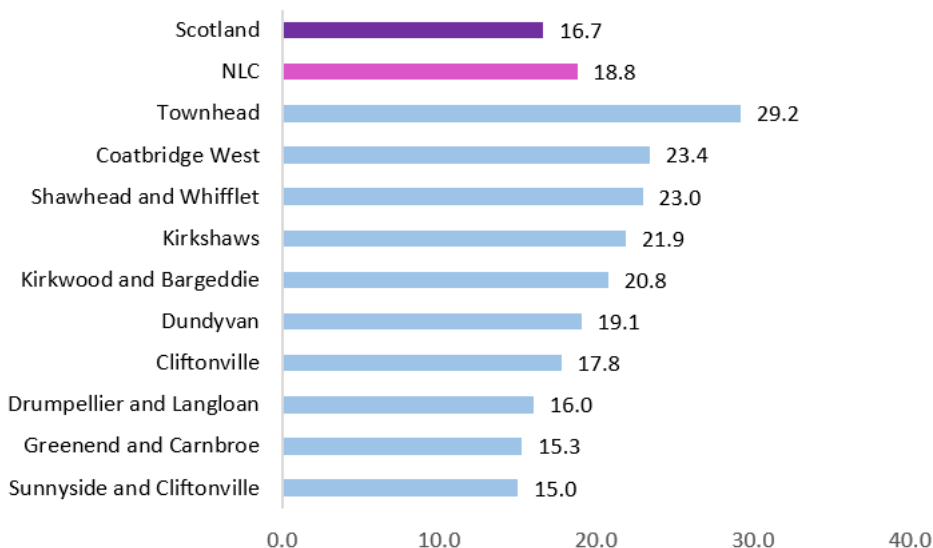
- While 18 datazones are within the 15% most health deprived areas of the country, the 5 datazones below are ranked within the 5% most health deprived.

- Coatbridge - Time Capsule – health rank 112

- Rosehall - Calder Avenue to Broughton Place – health rank 269

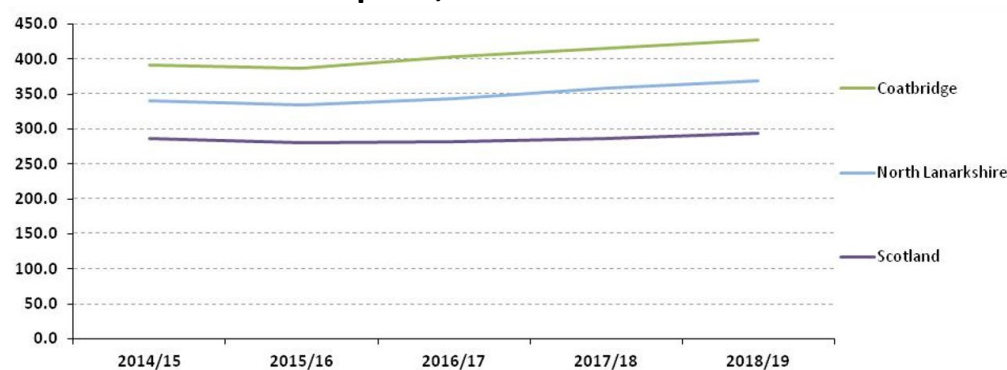
Children in low income households (%) August 2016

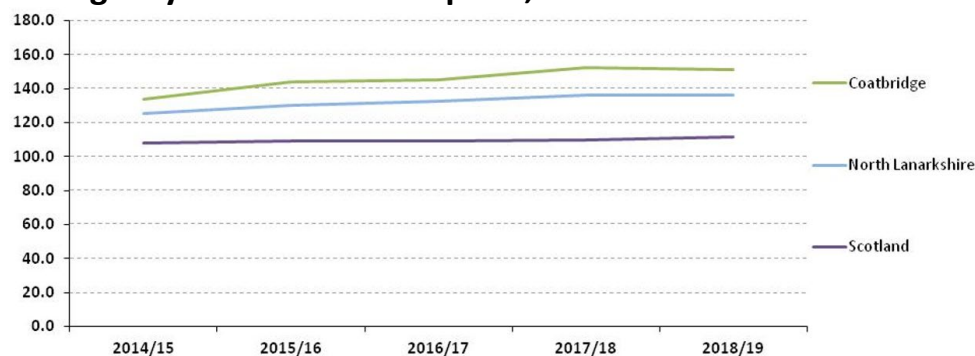

Coatbridge's A&E attendance rate has increased by around 10% over the last five years. The A&E attendance rate has remained consistently higher compared with North Lanarkshire and drastically higher than the national rate.

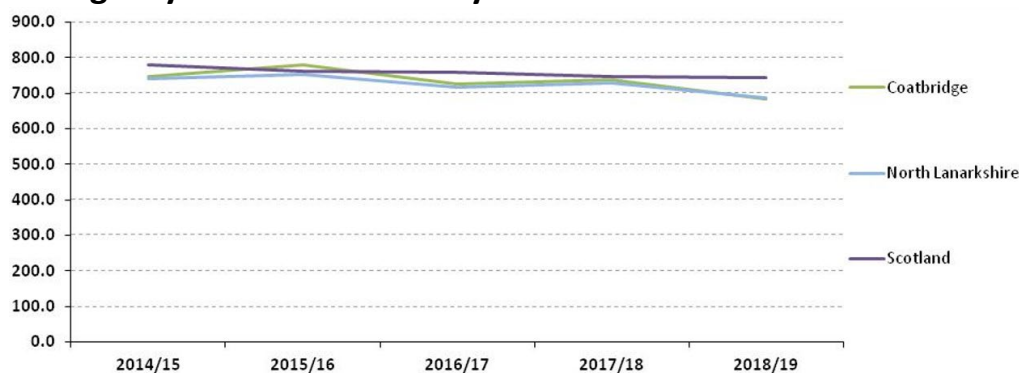

Coatbridge's emergency admission rate has increased by roughly 13% over the past five years however there has been a 1% decrease in the last year. It has continually had higher rates compared with North Lanarkshire and Scotland rates.

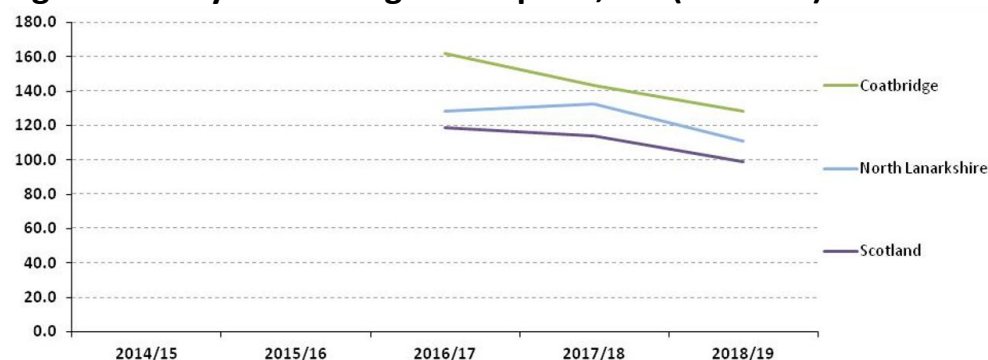

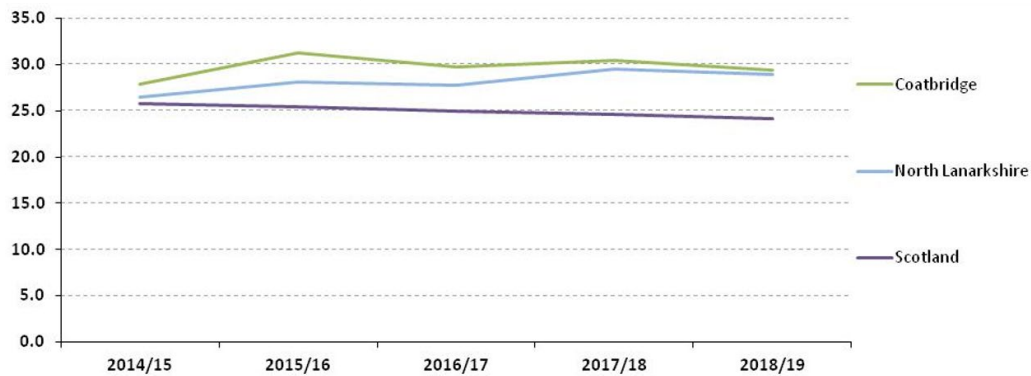
Age 18+ delayed discharges rate per 1,000 (Jul – Jun)

Coatbridge has the highest delayed discharge rate of all of North Lanarkshire's localities for the past 3 years. Although it remains higher than the Partnership and national rate, there has been a continual decrease over that time period too.

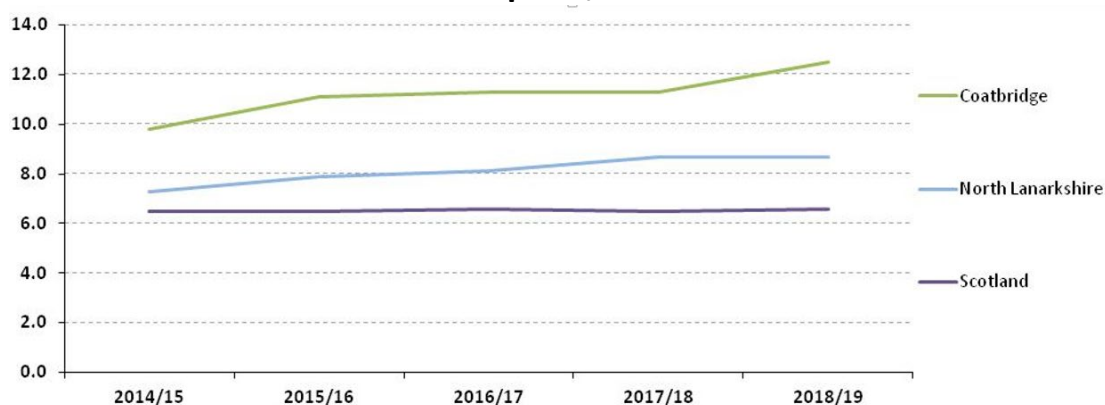
A&E conversion to hospital admission (%)

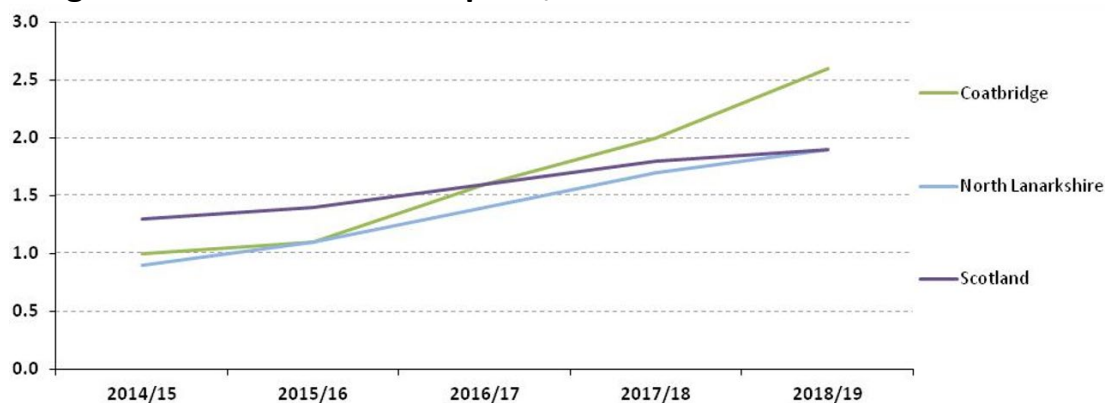

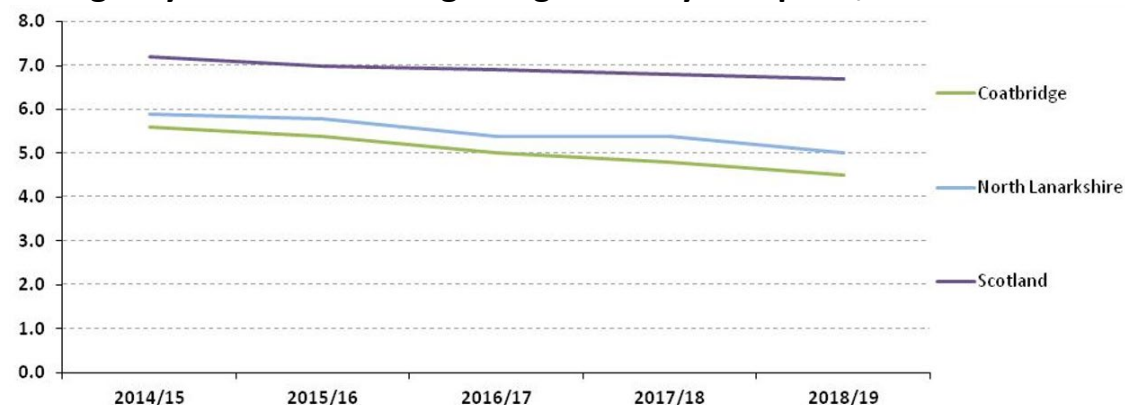

Emergency admission average length of stay rate per 1,000

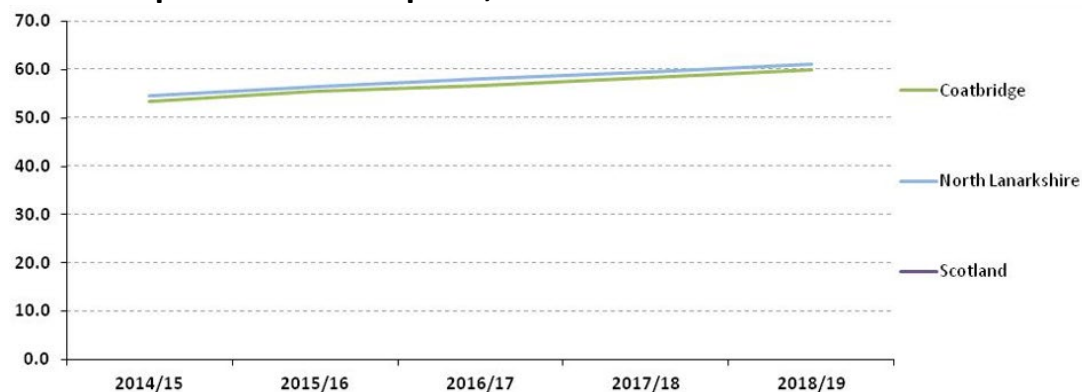

Coatbridge has the lowest average length of stay for emergency admissions; it also has the highest emergency admission and potentially preventable admission rates. This would show a potential for reducing overall admissions if preventable admission rates could be reduced.

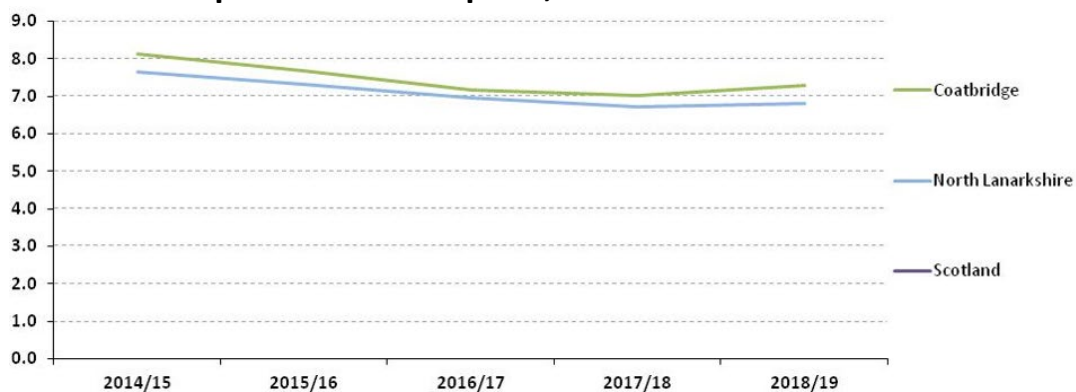

Despite the gradual year on year increase in diabetes prevalence in Coatbridge for the last 5 years, it has consistently remained below the North Lanarkshire average each year.

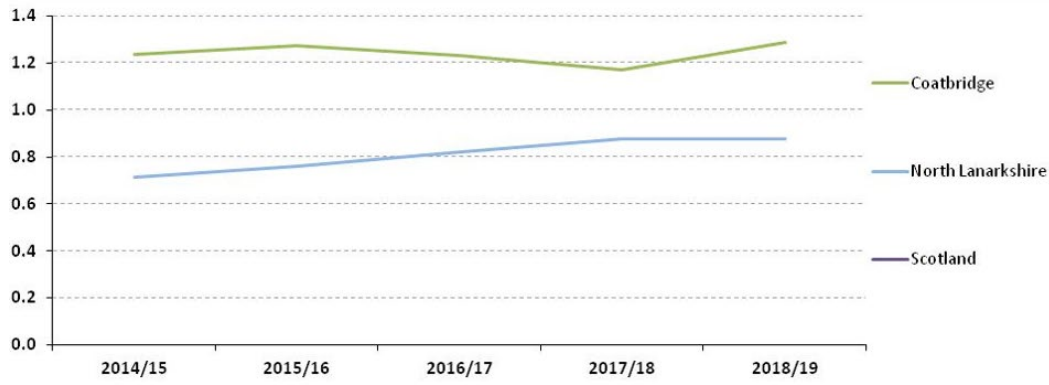
Heart failure prevalence rate per 1,000

Liver failure prevalence rate per 1,000



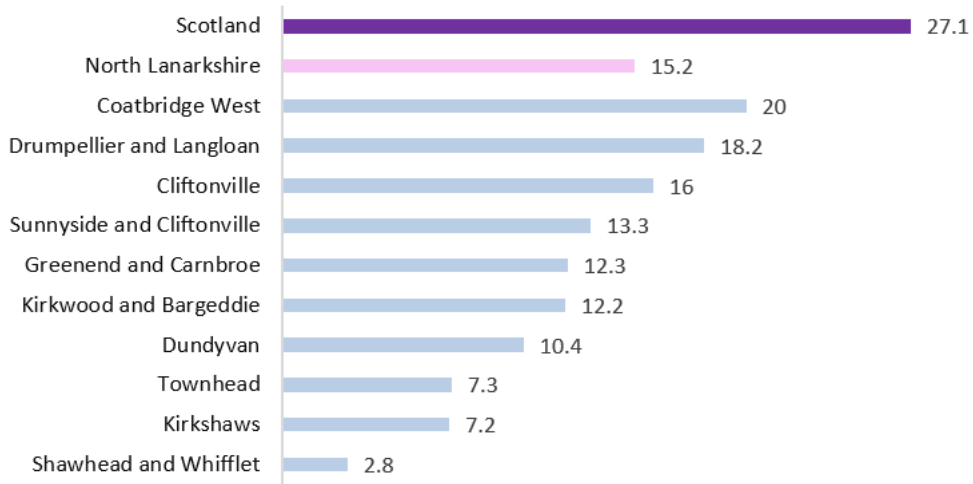

Coatbridge's liver failure rate per 1,000 has remained at a similar rate over the last 5 years; however remains the locality with the highest rate when compared to other localities.

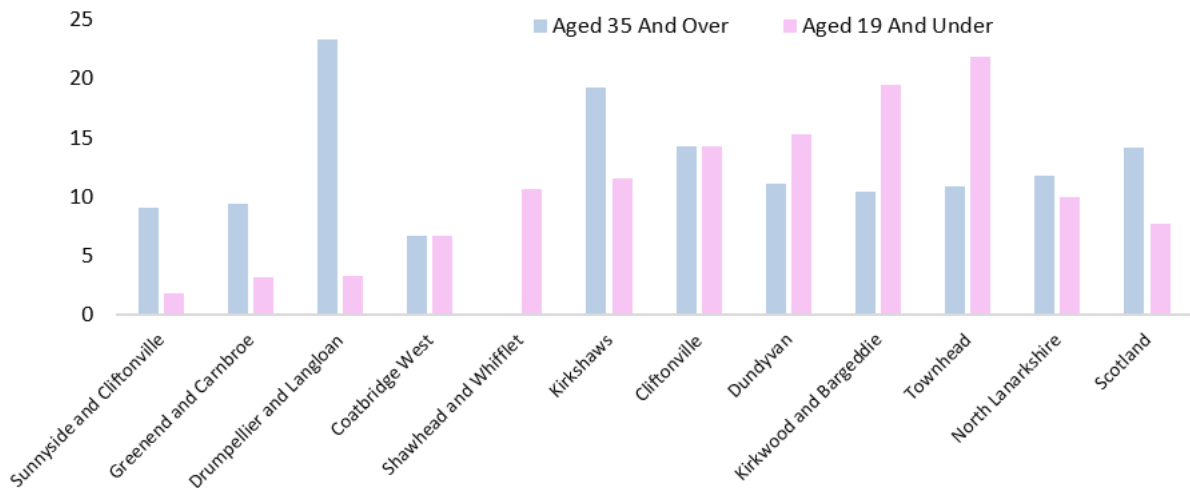
Mother and Baby Indicators

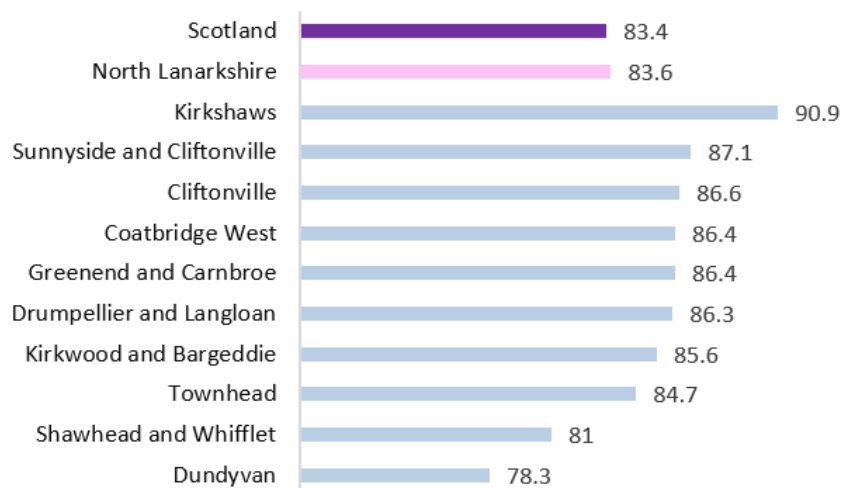
Babies exclusively breastfed at 6-8 weeks – 2015 based on 3 year aggregate (%)



Age of Older and Younger Mothers 2014-2017 3 year aggregate

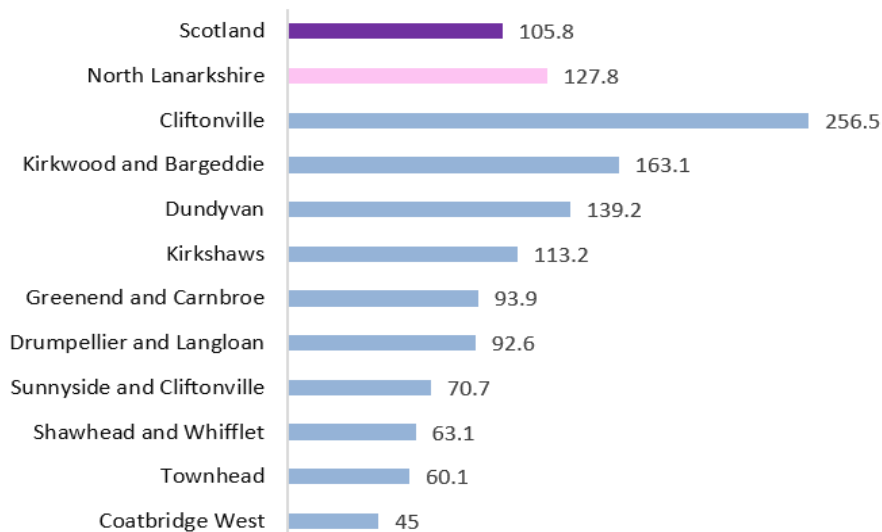


Healthy Birth Weight Babies, 2015 3 year aggregate (%)

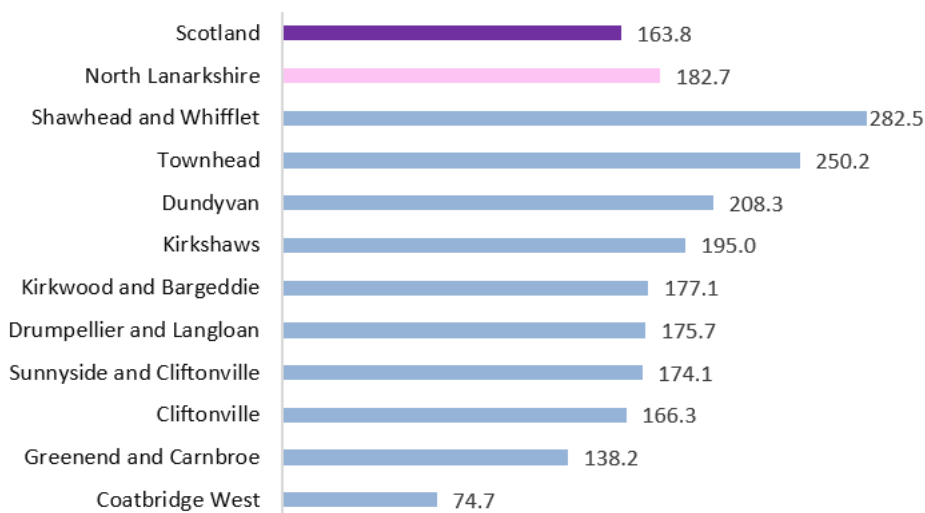

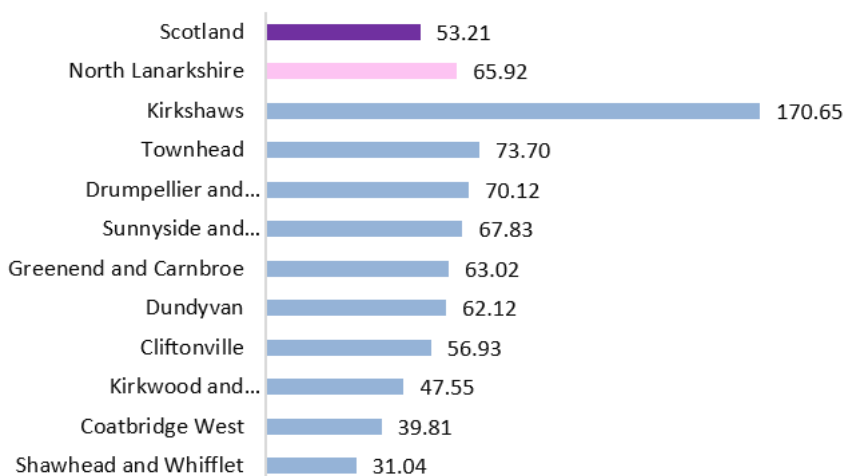
All-cause mortality among the 15-44 year olds 2016 (rate per 100,000)



Early Deaths from Cancer 2014-2016 3 year aggregate (rate per 100,000)

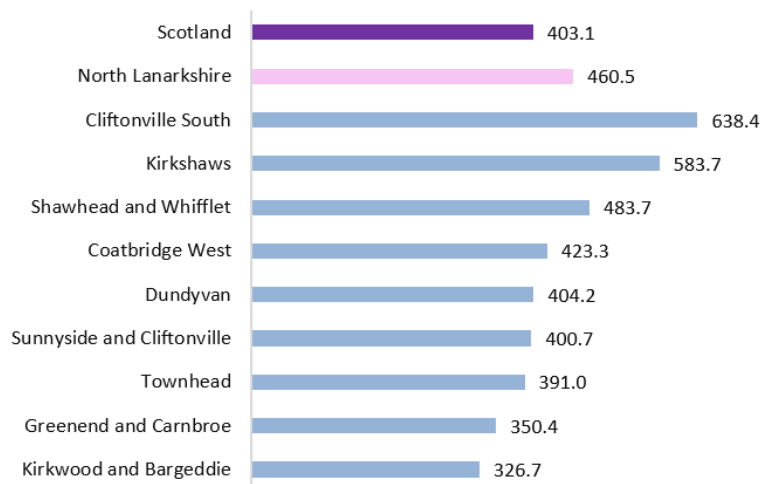


Early Deaths from Coronary Heart Disease (CHD) <75 years, 2015 (rate per 100,000)

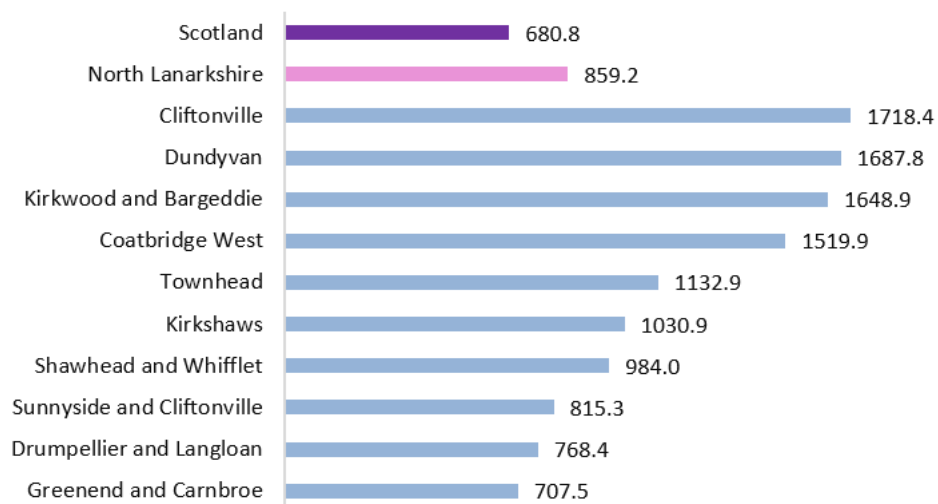

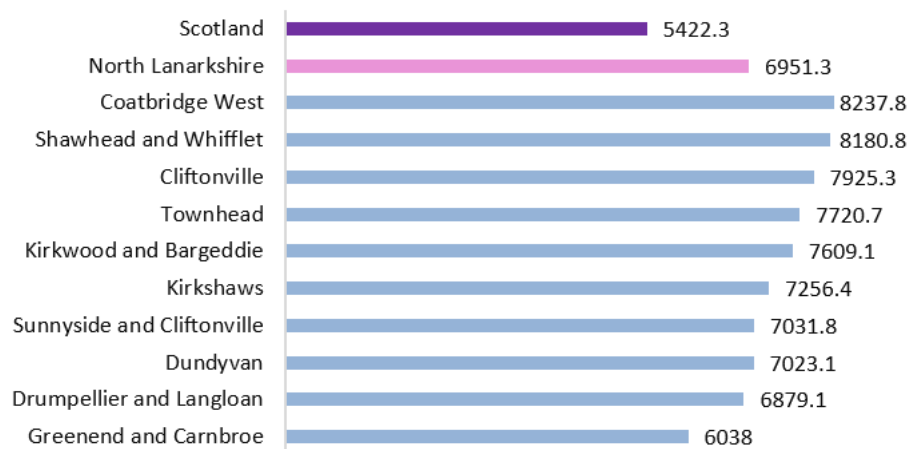
Patients Hospitalised with Coronary Heart Disease, 2014 (rate per 100,000)



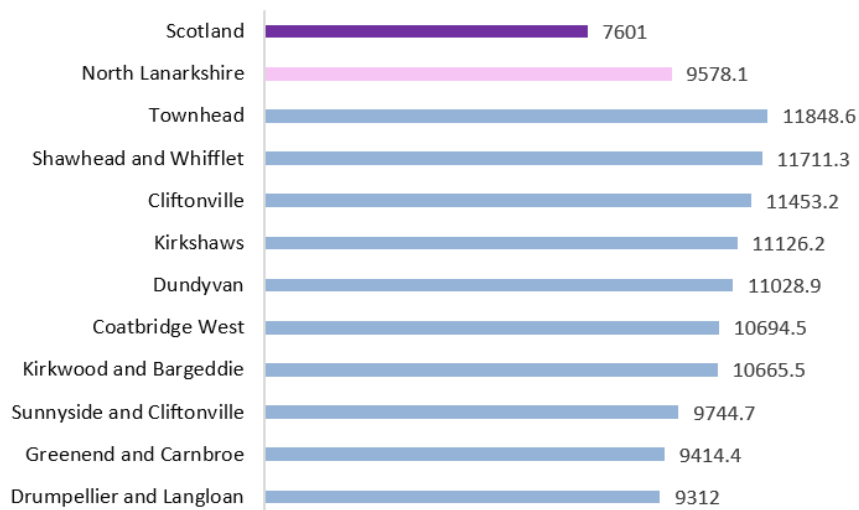
Alcohol Related Hospital Stays, 2016 (rate per 100,000)



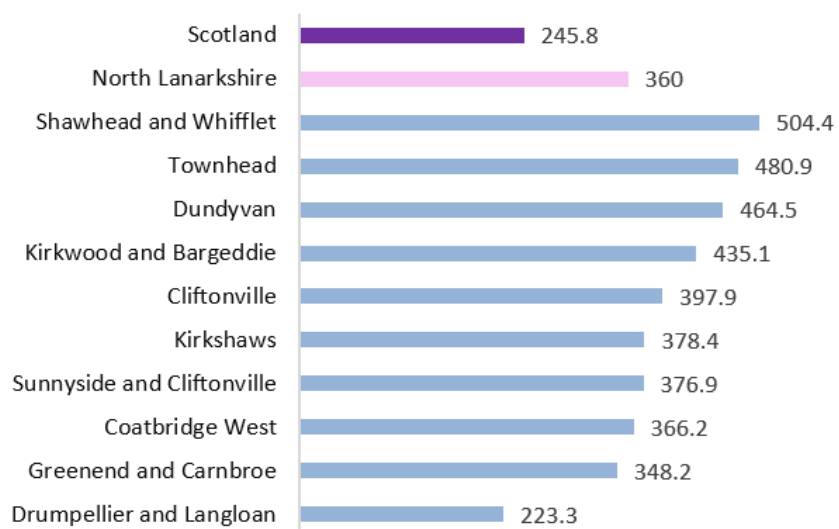
Patients (65+) with Multiple Emergency Hospitalisations 2016 (rate per 100,000)



Patients with Emergency Hospitalisations 2016 (rate per 100,000)

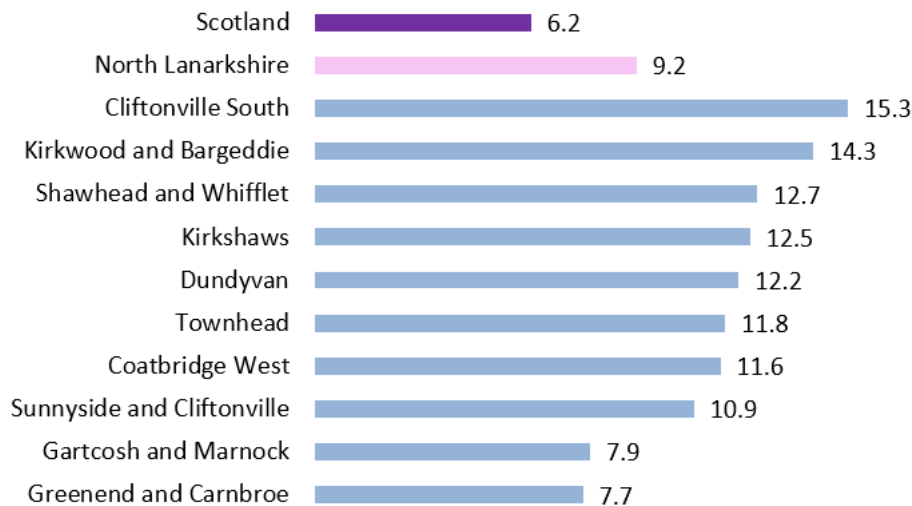


Patients Hospitalised with COPD 2014, 3-year aggregates 2013/14 to 2015/16 (rate per 100,000)

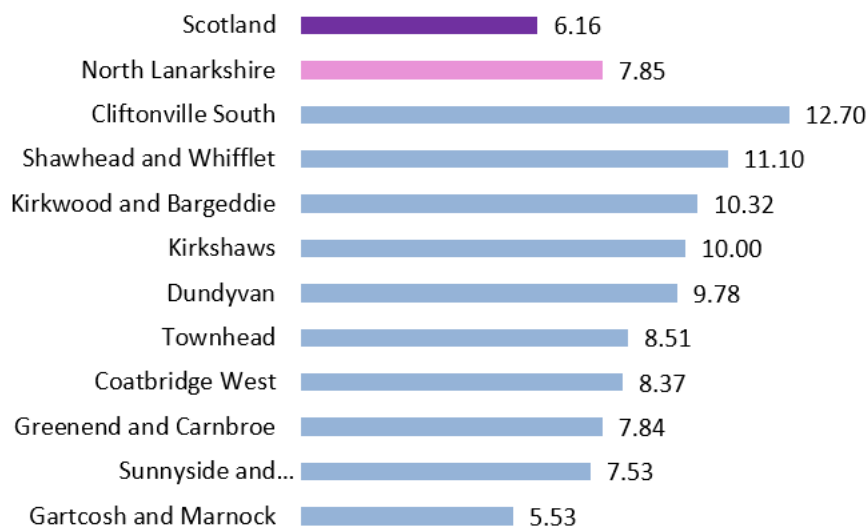

Adults Claiming Incapacity Benefit / Severe Disablement Allowance 2015 (%)

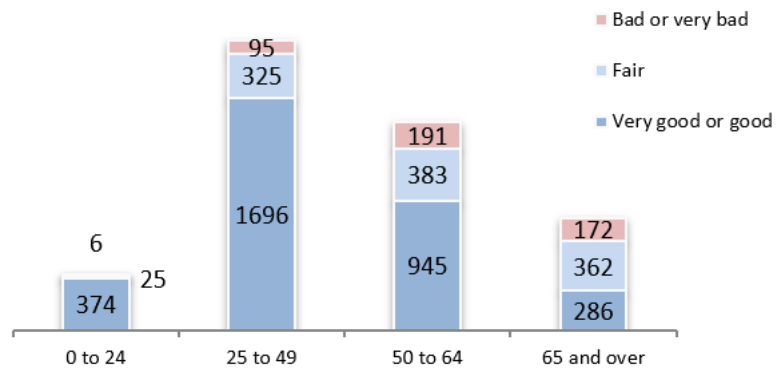
