




Geography




The 2019 North Lanarkshire population is 341,370.

Where the 65+ population live in North Lanarkshire 2019





Estimated life expectancy in Wishaw social work locality, 2016 (2014-2018 5 year aggregate)




- Male life expectancy is highest in Craigneuk, Airdrie at 85.5 years and lowest in Craigneuk, Wishaw at 65.0 years
- Female life expectancy is highest in 2 areas Balloch East and Stepps (87.2 years) and lowest in Craigneuk, Wishaw (69.1 years).





SIMD by datazone

The graph below is from the Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD) 2020. It shows the percentage of people who are income and employment deprived within the locality. The number of people who are income deprived includes dependants of someone who is income deprived. This <u>webpage</u>³ provides information of the range of income and employment deprivation across North Lanarkshire.



Within the SIMD 2020, other issues highlighted by the data are:

Twenty datazones (of 78 datazones) within Wishaw SW locality are ranked within the 15% most deprived areas of the country.

- Craigneuk Meadowhead Street to Kimberley Street SIMD rank 49
- Gowkthrapple Birkenshaw Brae- SIMD rank 53
- Craigneuk Flaxmill Avenue to Aldersyde Avenue SIMD rank 55


The four datazones shown below are within the 5% most health deprived in the country.

- Craigneuk Meadowhead Street to Kimberley Street health rank 39
- Wishawhill Briarwood Road to Wishaw North Junction health rank 50
- Craigneuk Laurel Drive to Wishaw Hospital health rank 120
- Craigneuk Flaxmill Avenue to Aldersyde Avenue health rank 189

22 of the 78 datazones rank within the 15% most education deprived areas of the country, with 3 datazones below in ranking 1, 3 5 most deprived in the country.

- Craigneuk Flaxmill Avenue to Aldersyde Avenue education rank 1
- Gowkthrapple Birkenshaw Brae education rank 3
- Wishawhill Briarwood Road to Wishaw North Junction education rank 5


Children in low income households (%) August 2016



Wishaw's A&E attendance rate has increased by around 12% over the last five years. It has remained broadly similar to the North Lanarkshire rate, however is well above the National rate.



Wishaw's emergency admissions rate has increased approximately 9% over the last five years. It has remained broadly similar to the North Lanarkshire rate, both of which are above the national rate.


Emergency admission bed day rate per 1,000

Wishaw has consistently had the highest emergency admission bed day rate in North Lanarkshire over the last five years. The rate has decreased over 2018/19 and is nearly on par with the Scotland rate, but still remains the highest in North Lanarkshire.



Wishaw has followed a similar trend with the North Lanarkshire delayed discharge rate, where it increased in 2017/18, which was followed by a decrease in 2018/19. Despite Wishaw being above the National rate, it has now fallen below the partnership rate for the first time.


A&E conversion to hospital admission (%)

Wishaw's A&E to admission conversion rate has continually increased over the last 5 years where it crept above the national rate in 2016/17. However it has decreased in 2018/19 and remains consistently below the North Lanarkshire total percentage.


7 day readmission rate per 1,000

Wishaw has the second highest 7 day readmission rate of the 6 localities in North Lanarkshire. It has consistently been above the partnership rate and National rate.



Wishaw's 2 plus admissions rate has continually grown at a greater rate than the partnership average since 2015/16.

Long Term Conditions (Scotland data unavailable)

Overall, Wishaw has had the highest rates in North Lanarkshire for many indicators particularly for LTC's. Coincidentally, 70% of the Wishaw population live in SIMD quintiles 1 and 2 i.e. the most deprived areas.



Wishaw's chronic pain prevalence rate has increased by around 7% over the past five years. In each of the years it has had the highest rate amongst the North Lanarkshire localities.


COPD/Asthma Prevalence

Osteoarthritis Prevalence





Wishaw's osteoarthritis rate has increased by around 17% over the last five years. It has continually had the highest rate amongst the North Lanarkshire localities over this time period.


Mother and Baby Indicators


Babies exclusively breastfed at 6-8 weeks - 2015 based on 3 year aggregate (%)



Age of Older and Younger Mothers 2014-2017 3 year aggregate (%)




Healthy Birth Weight Babies, 2015 3 year aggregate (%)



Early Deaths from Cancer 2014-2016 3 year aggregate (rate per 100,000)




Early Deaths from Coronary Heart Disease (CHD) <75 years, 2015 (rate per 100,000)




Patients Hospitalised with Coronary Heart Disease, 2014 (rate per 100,000)




Alcohol Related Hospital Stays, 2016 (rate per 100,000)




Patients (65+) with Multiple Emergency Hospitalisations 2016 (rate per 100,000)



Patients with Emergency Hospitalisations 2016 (rate per 100,000)




Patients Hospitalised with COPD 2014, 3-year aggregates 2013/14 to 2015/16 (rate per 100,000)

Adults Claiming Incapacity Benefit / Severe Disablement Allowance 2015 (%)


