The Burgh of Airdrie (Carlisle Road A73) (40mph Speed Limit Restriction) Order 1967, The Strathclyde Regional Council (Restricted Roads) (Transitional) Order 1985 and The North Lanarkshire Council (St Edwards and Tollbrae Primary Schools, A73 Motherwell Street and A73 Carlisle Road, Airdrie) 30 MPH and Part Time 20 MPH Speed Limit Order 2014 are hereby amended as specified in Schedule II of this Order.

From a point on A73 Motherwell Street, 47 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Dykehead Road, south eastwards to a point on A73 Carlisle Road, 723 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Craigneuk Avenue, a distance of 3089 metres or thereby.
