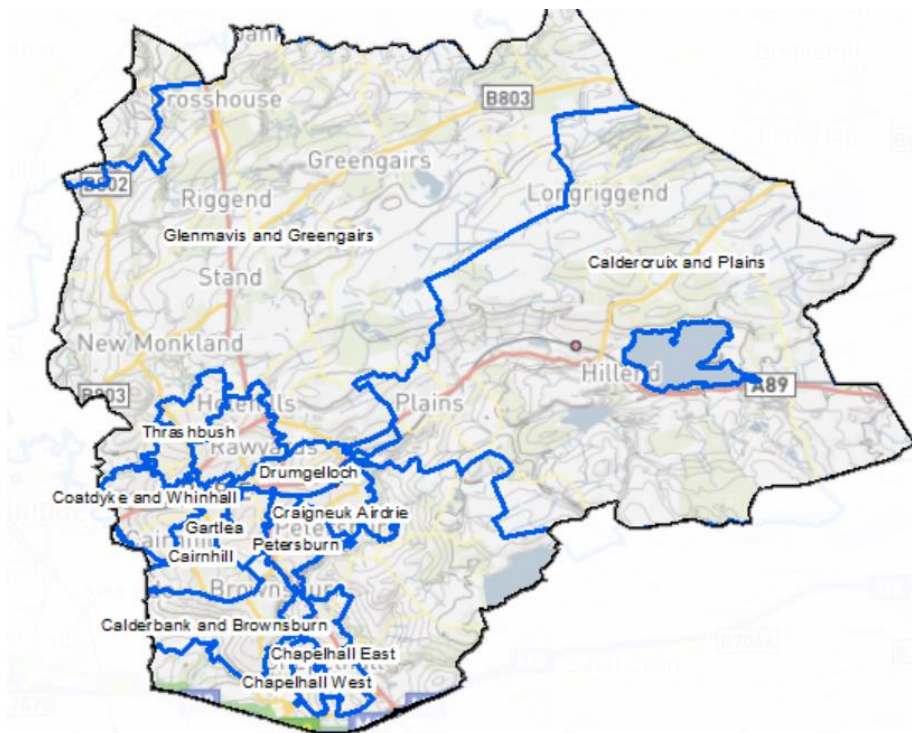
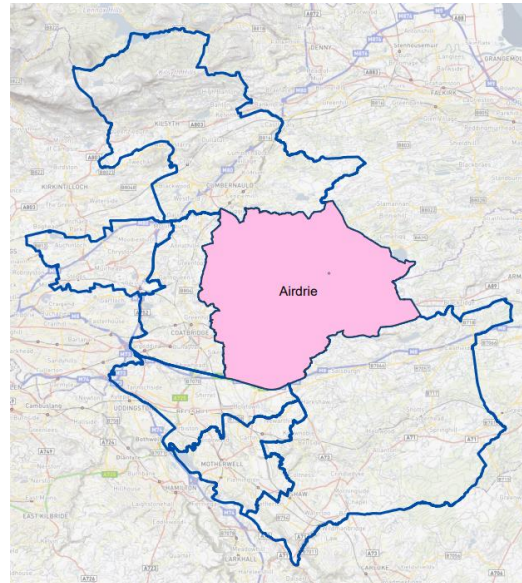
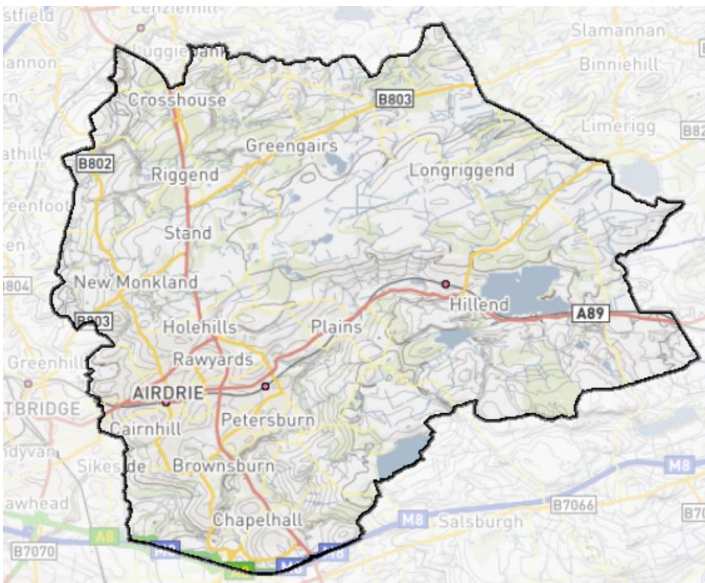


Airdrie Health and Social Care Locality Profile

Geography

There are six health and social care localities across North Lanarkshire. The data in this profile is presented at intermediate datazone geography where possible, these 78 geographies have been allocated to the locality areas on a best fit basis. Some data is shown at ward level when this is the only availability.

The data is drawn from public sources and should be considered with local knowledge and consideration of the confidence levels around the data. Confidence bars are on each graph, these show that the true value for that indicator could fall between the upper and lower confidence level.

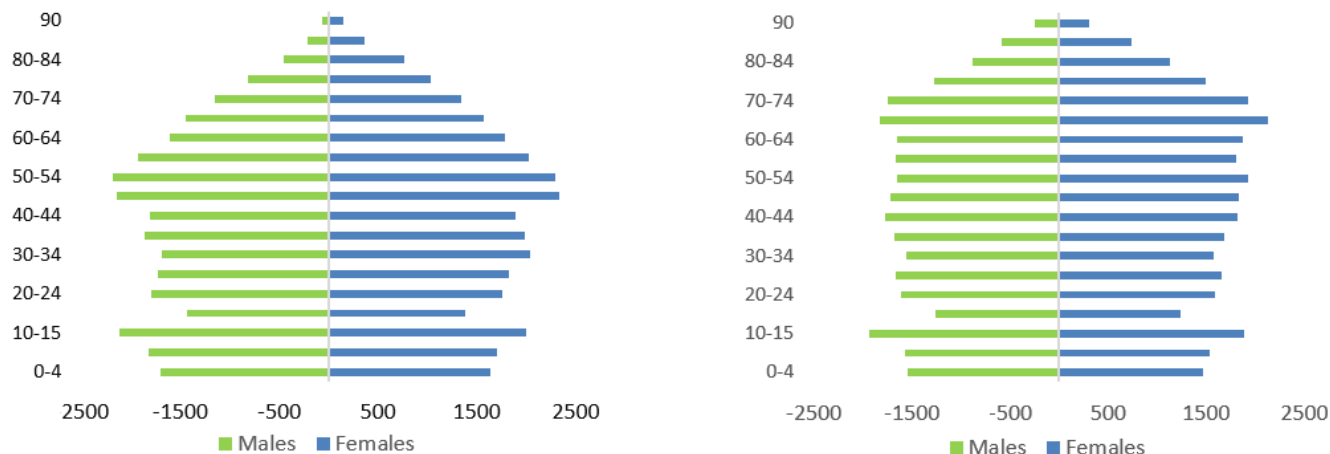

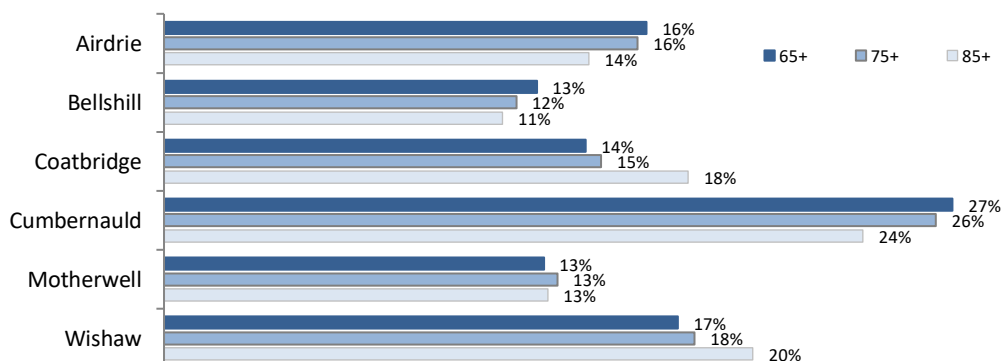

Where the 65+ population live - 2021



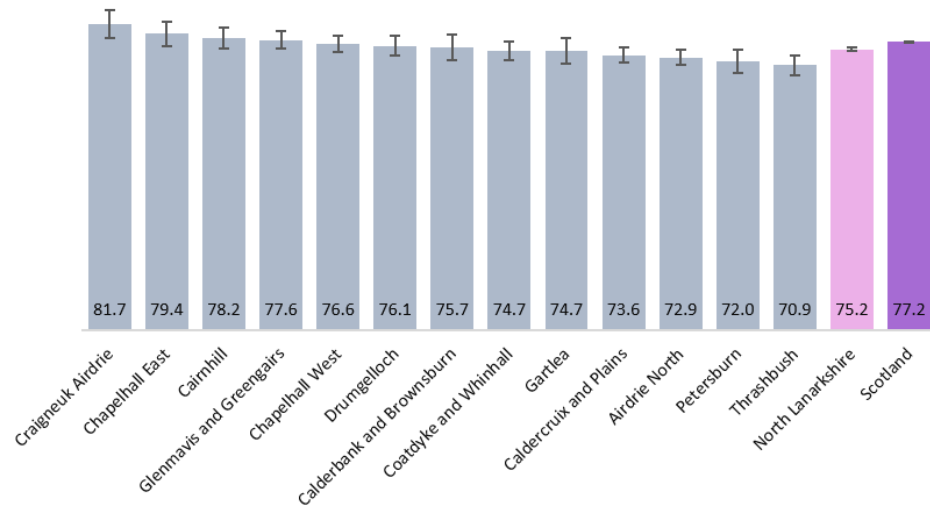

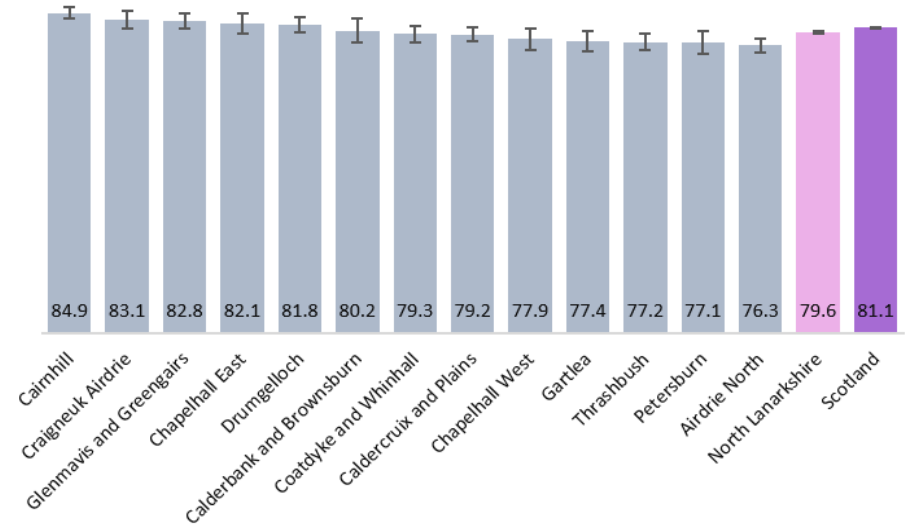

Life expectancy 2015-2019, 5 year aggregate, males



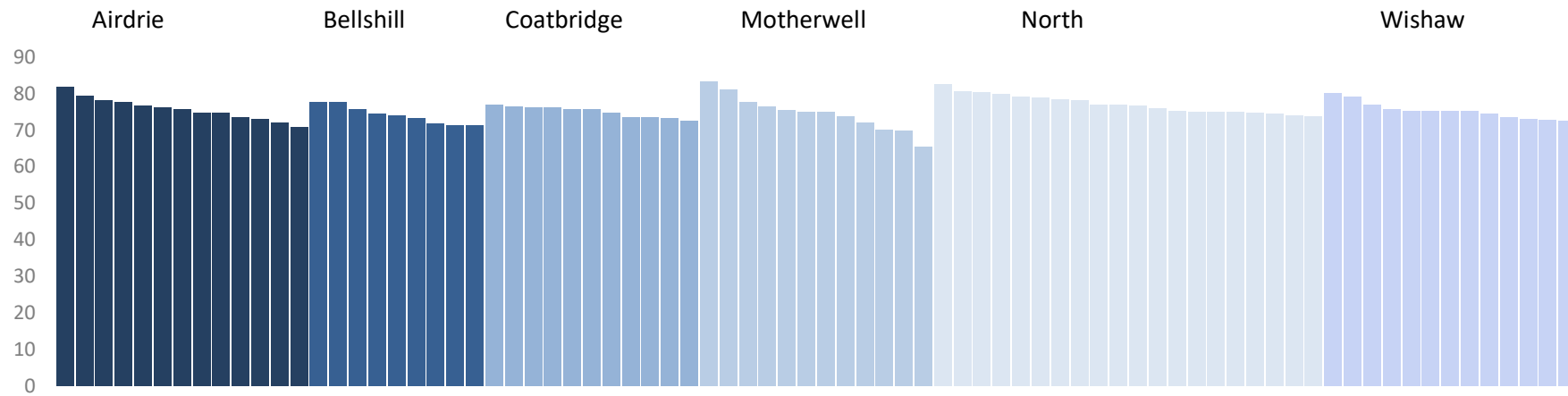
Life expectancy 2015-2019 5 year aggregate, females



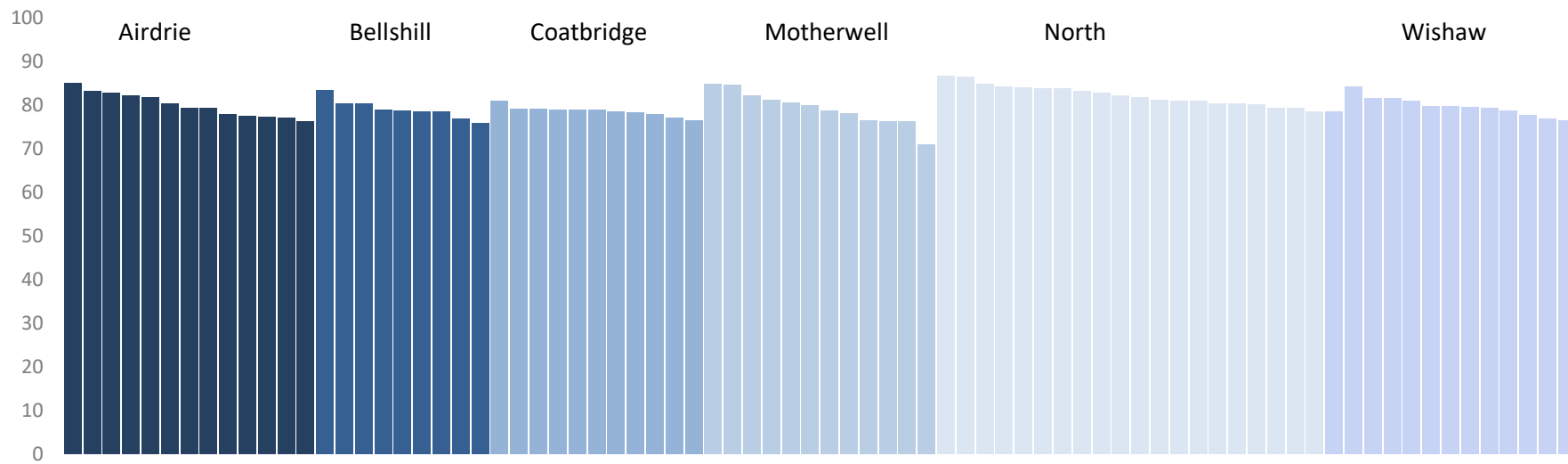

Male Life Expectancy 2017 Localities in North Lanarkshire



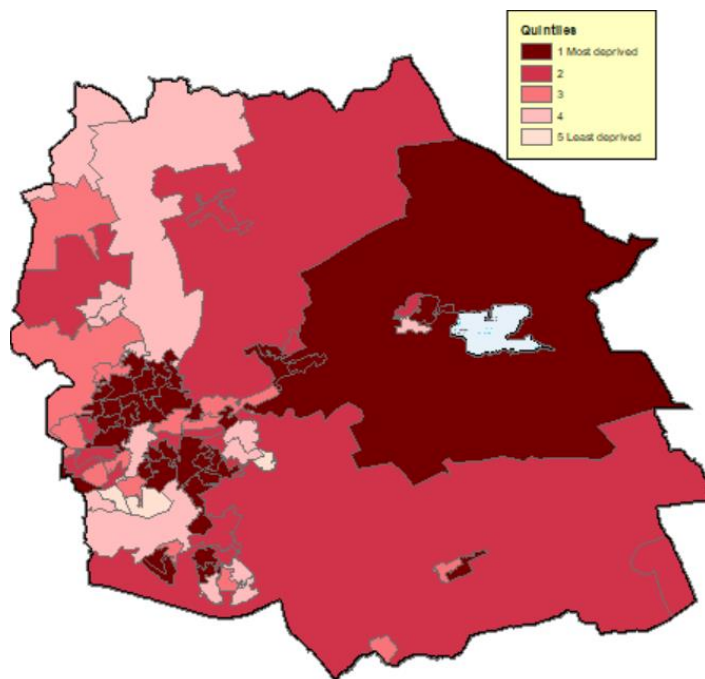
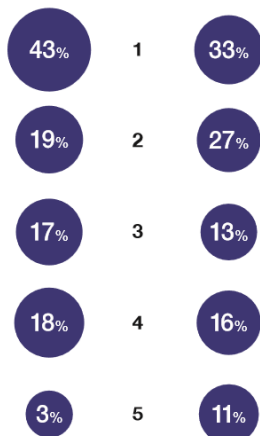
Female Life Expectancy 2017 Localities in North Lanarkshire

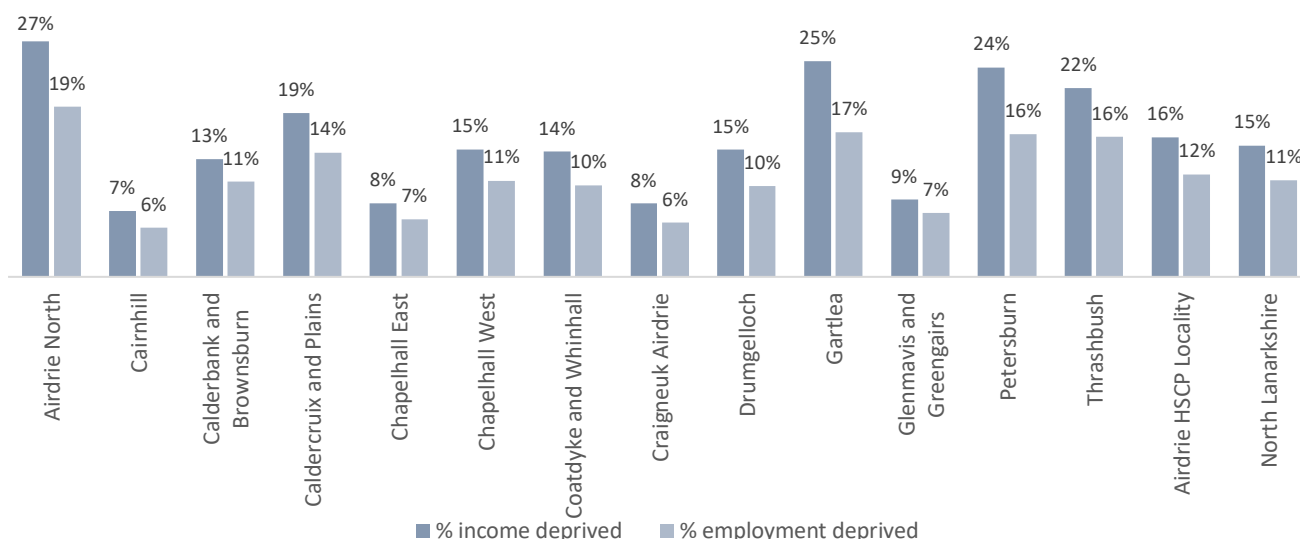

The graph below is from the Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD) 2020. It shows the percentage of people who are income and employment deprived within the locality. The number income deprived people include dependants of someone who is income deprived. Income and Employment Deprivation – % of intermediate datazone population SIMD 2020



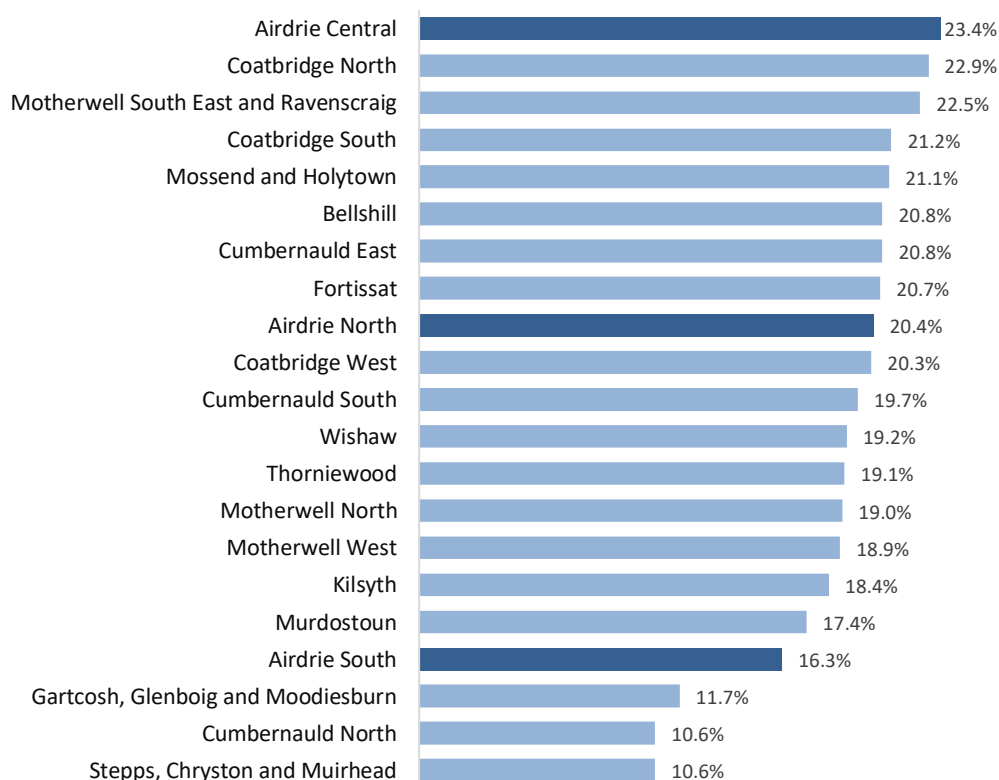
Within the SIMD 2020, other issues highlighted by the data are (1=most deprived; 6976 = least deprived):

- 3 Airdrie datazones are in the most acutely deprived 5% nationally:

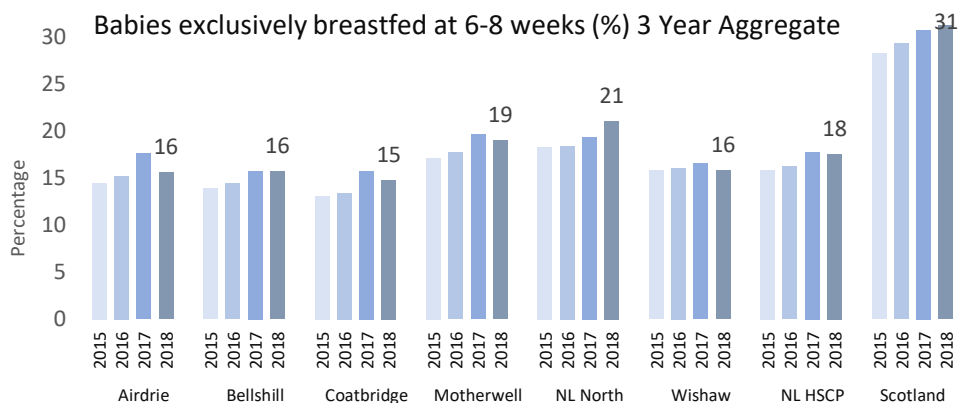
- Whinhall - Park Street to Whinhall Avenue Rank 119
 - Whinhall – Whinhall Avenue to Mavisbank Park Rank 168
 - Whinhall - Mavisbank Street to Willowpark Court Rank 283
- 27 of these 78 datazones in Airdrie, are within the 15% most deprived communities in the country
 - 35 datazones are in the 20% most deprived communities across Scotland (also known as SIMD 1)
 - Around 9,227 (16%) people in the Airdrie locality are income deprived. The North Lanarkshire figure is 15% across and Scottish average is 12%.
 - 4,397 (12%) people of working age are employment deprived, across North Lanarkshire it is 11% and 9% across Scotland.
 - Within the health domain, 54 datazones are in the 20% most deprived in Scotland (SIMD 1), 35 are within the 15% most health deprived areas nationally and 12 Airdrie datazones are within the 10% most deprived communities in Scotland, within this, 3 are in the 5% most acutely deprived category.
 - Whinhall - Park Street to Whinhall Avenue SIMD Health Rank = 100
 - Airdrie - Flowerhill Street to Hunter Street SIMD Health Rank = 309
 - Whinhall - Whinhall Ave to Mavisbank Park SIMD Health Rank = 312

Percentage of children (aged under 16) living in relative low-income families 2021 (before housing costs)

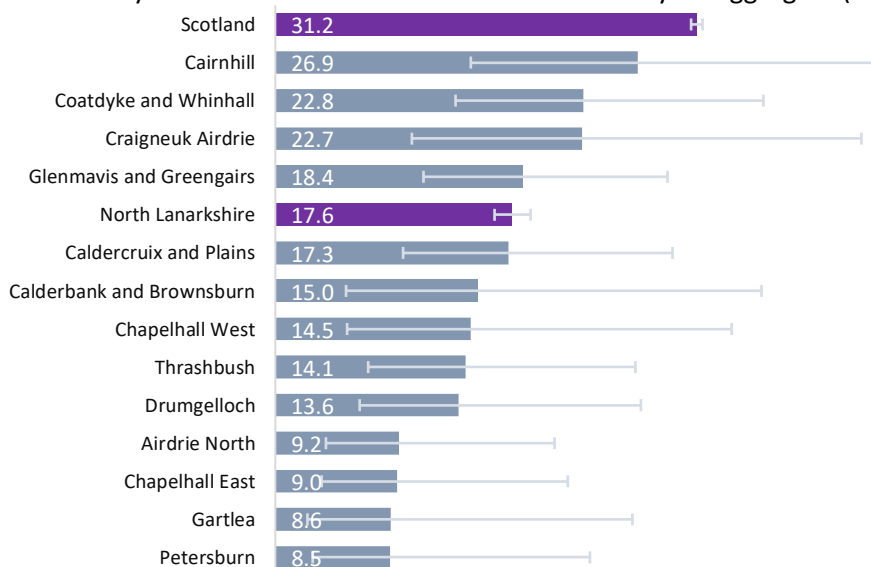


The 3 wards highlighted make up Airdrie HSCP locality. The North Lanarkshire figure is 19% and Scottish figure is 175,009, also 19%.

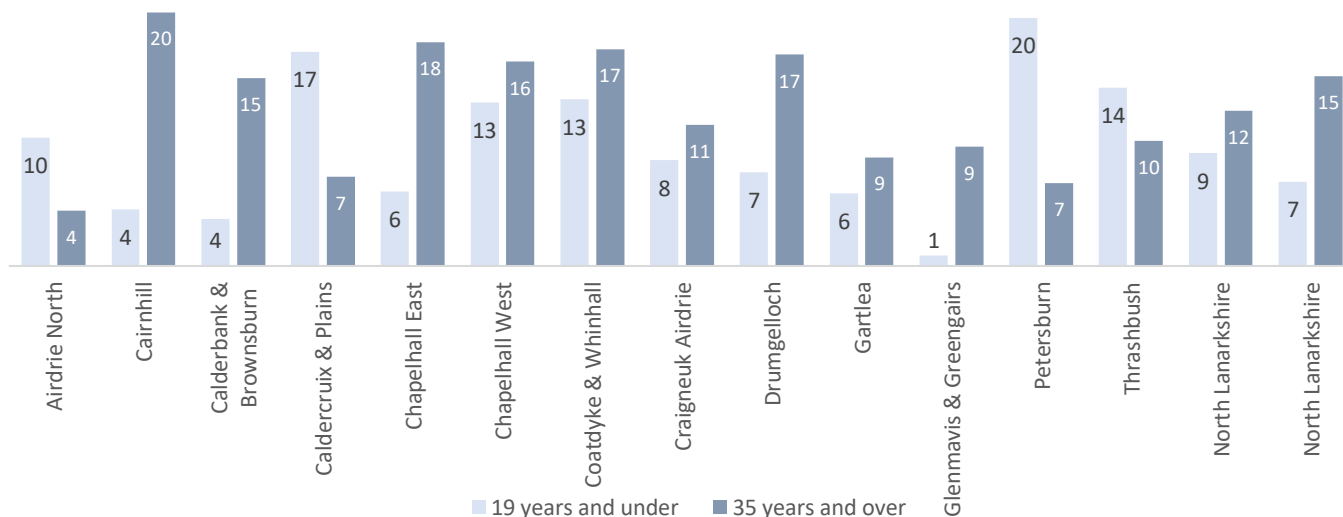


Babies exclusively breastfed at 6-8 weeks – 2018 based on 3-year aggregate (%)

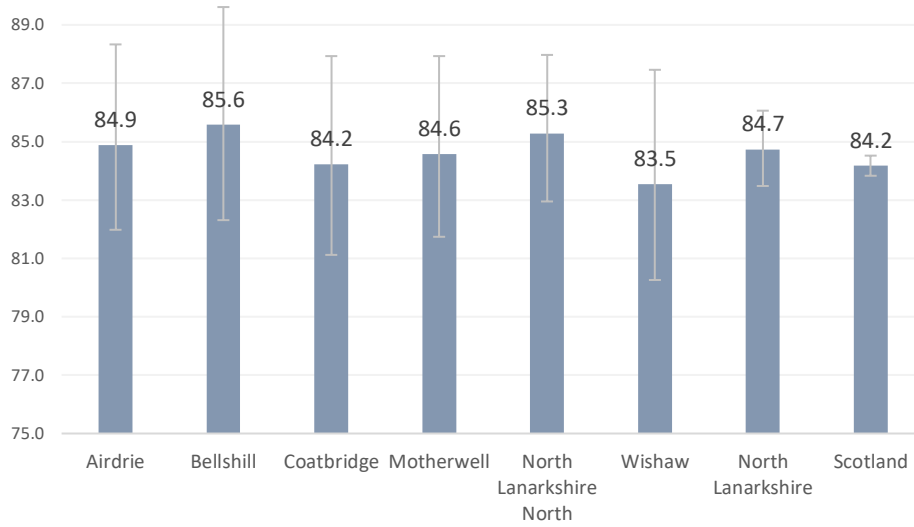

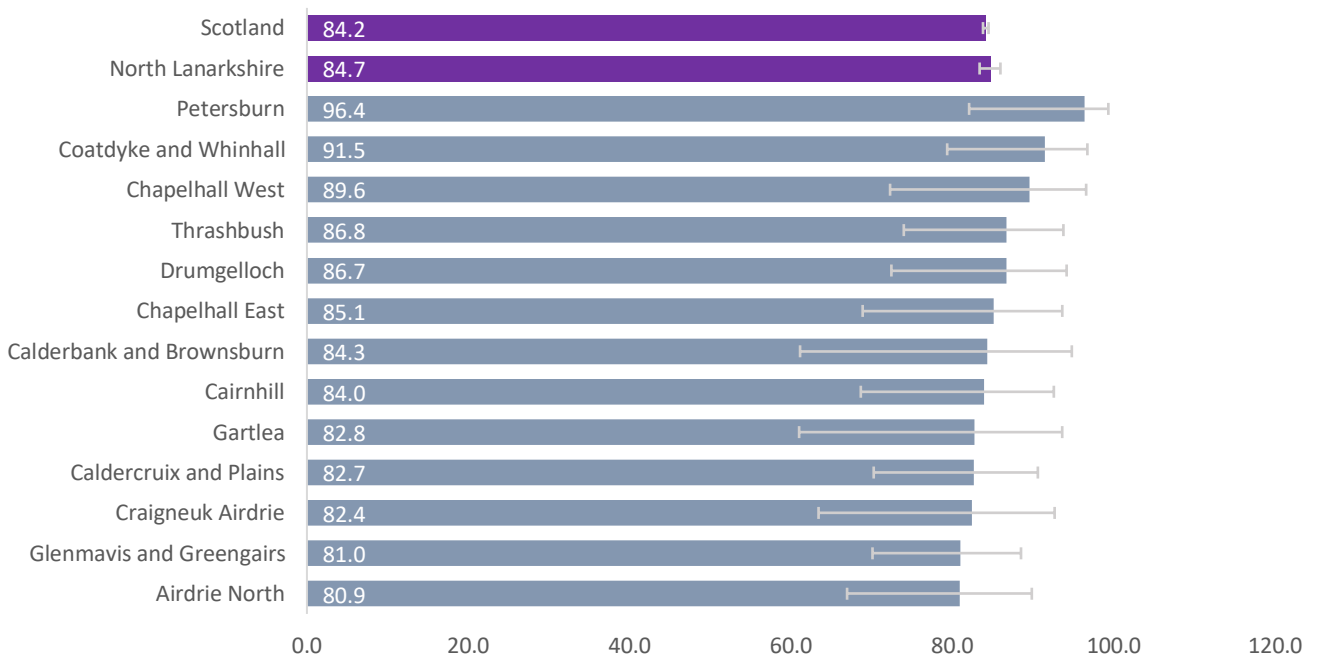
Age of first time mothers 2016/17-2018/19, 3-year aggregate (%)



Percentage of healthy birth weight babies, 2018/19 to 2020/21 financial years; 3-year aggregate

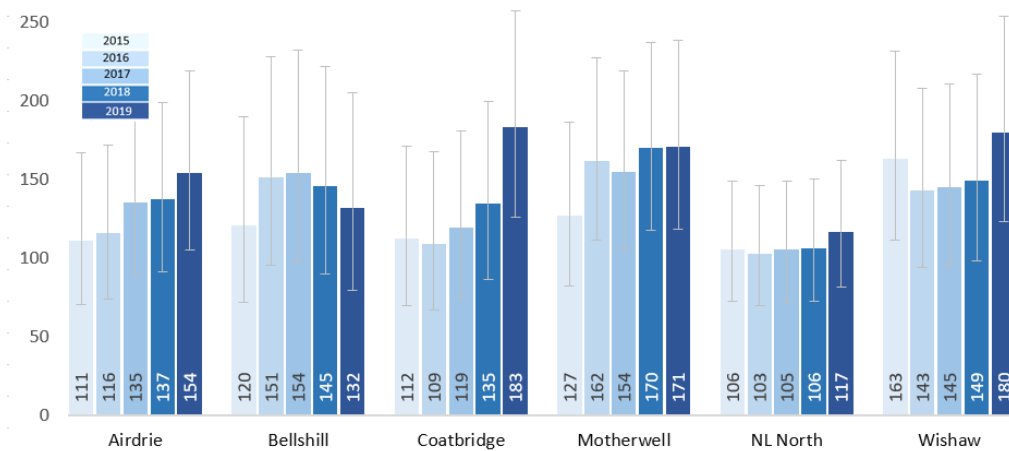


Percentage of healthy birth weight babies, 2018/19 to 2020/21 financial years; 3-year aggregate – intermediate datazones in Airdrie

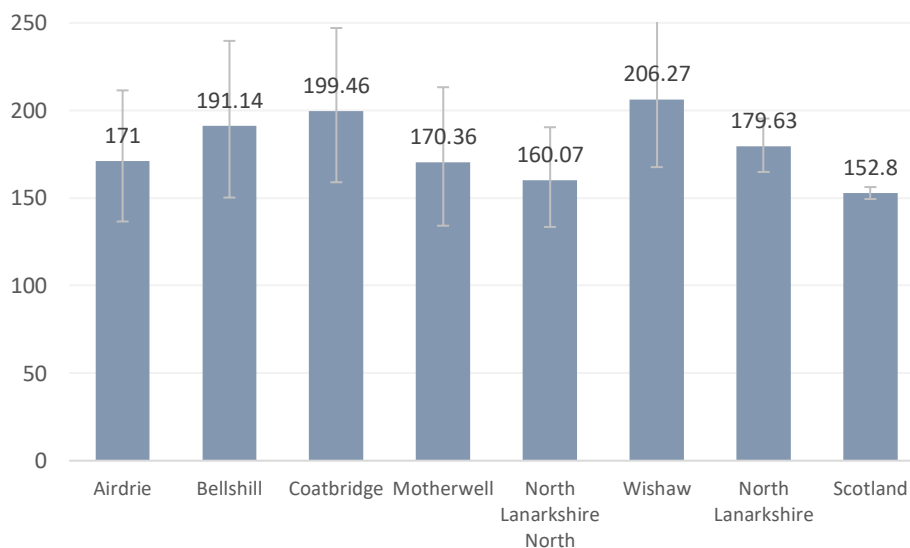

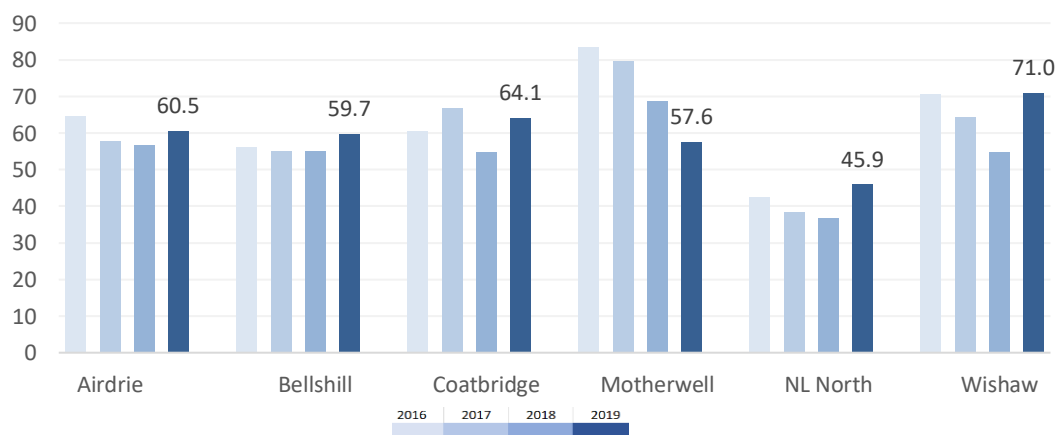
Deaths aged 15-44 years 2015 to 2019 - age-sex standardised rate per 100,000 3- year aggregate



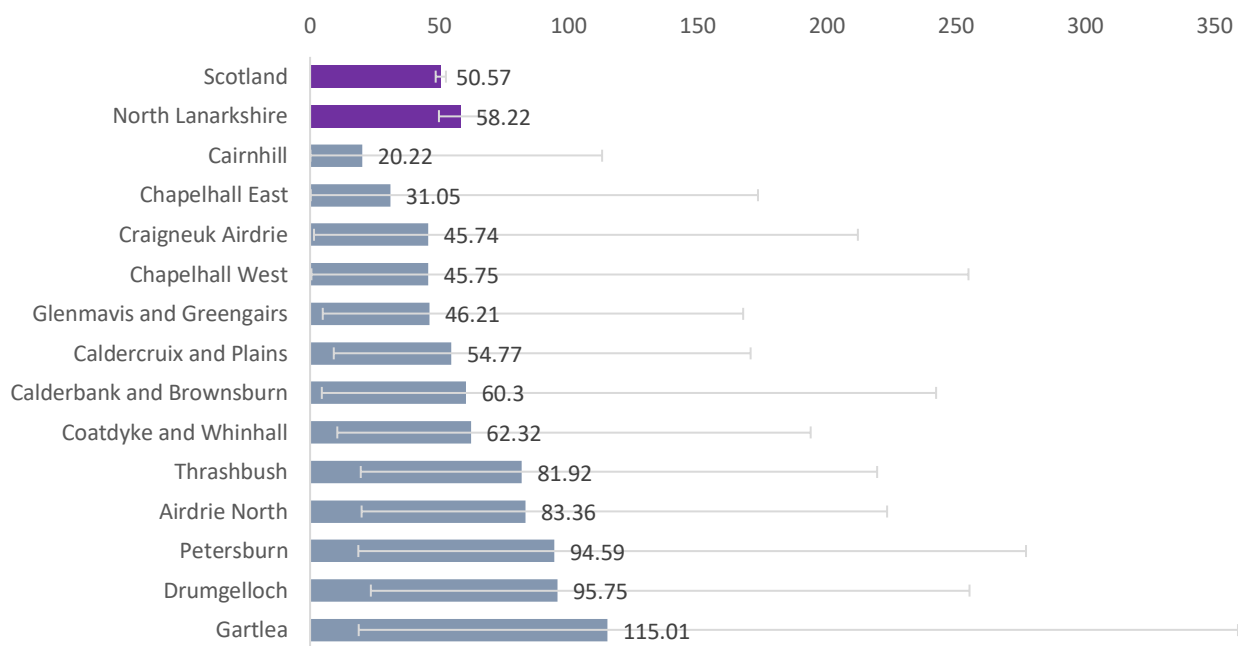
Early deaths from cancer 2018-2020 3 year aggregate (rate per 100,000)



Early deaths from coronary heart disease (CHD), aged <75 years, 2016-2020 3-year aggregate

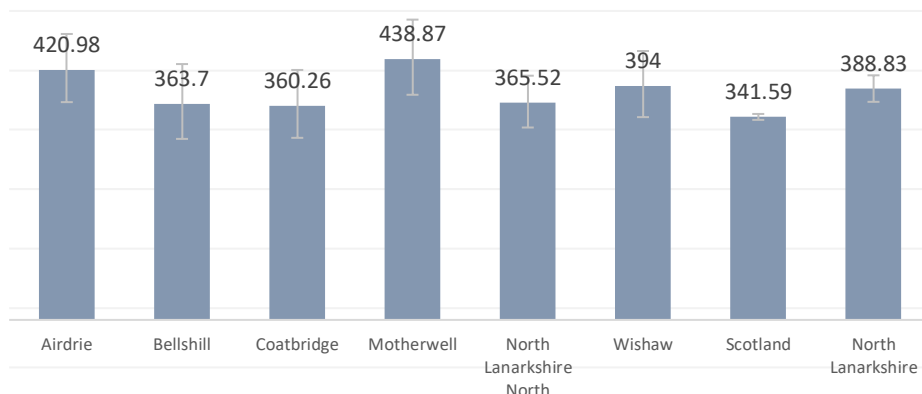


Early deaths from coronary heart disease (CHD), aged <75 years – 2018 to 2020 calendar years; 3-year aggregate

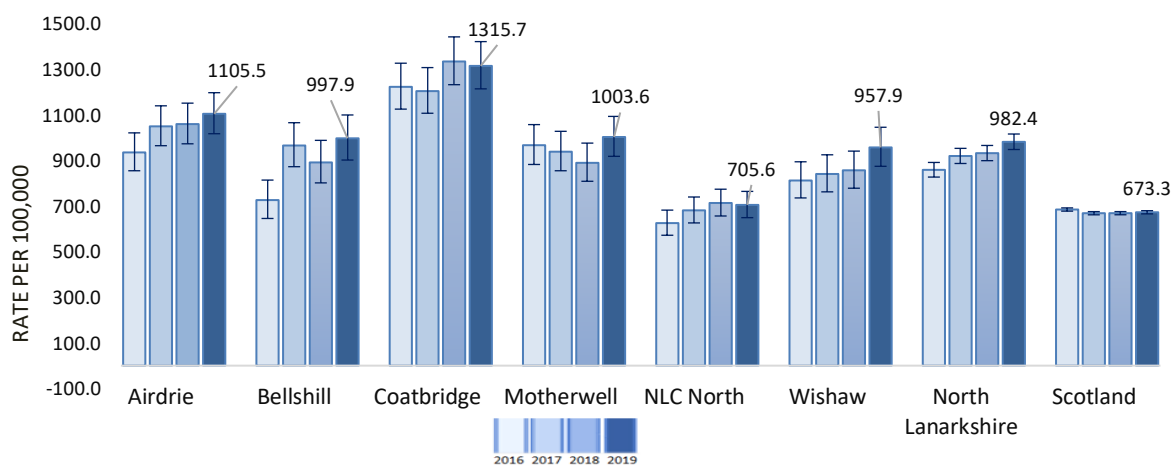

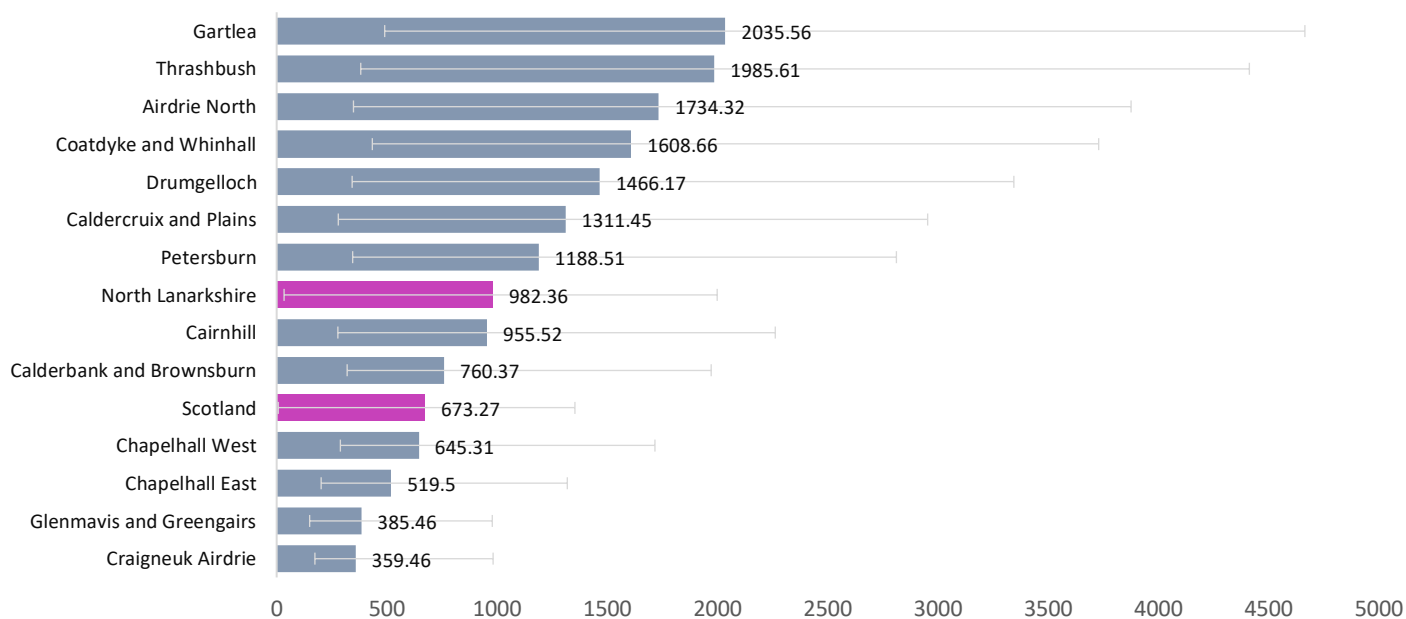
Coronary heart disease (CHD) patient hospitalisations 2019/20 to 2021/22 financial years; 3-year aggregate



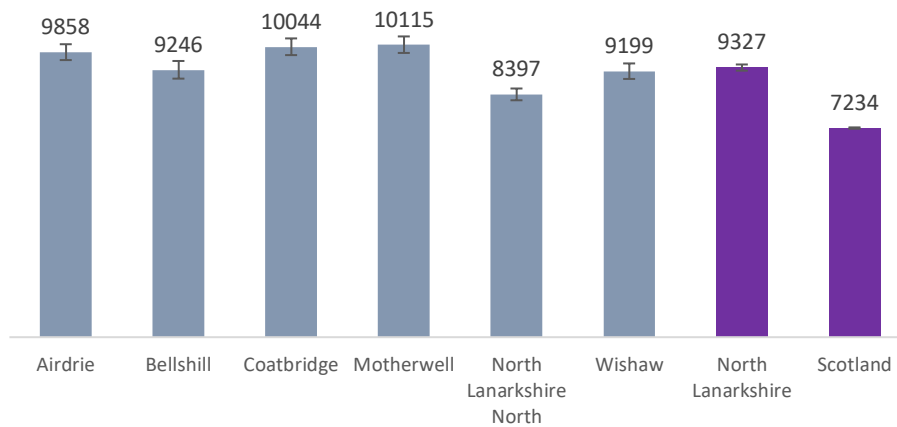
Alcohol related hospital admissions 2016-2019 Age-sex standardised rate per 100,000



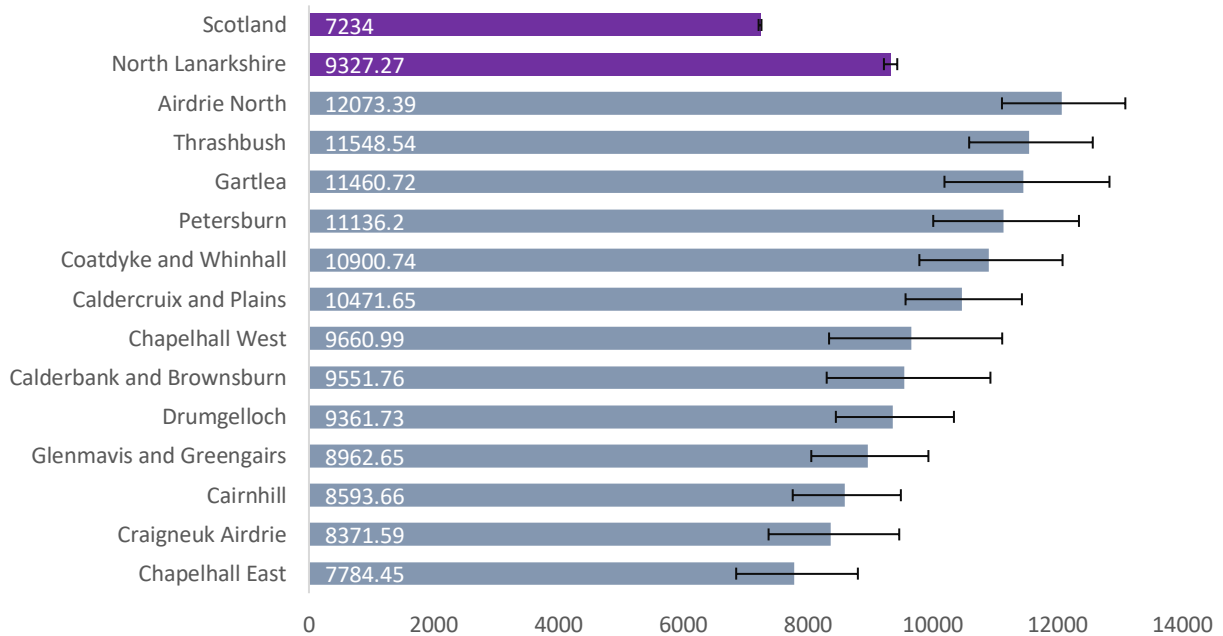
Airdrie - alcohol-related hospital admissions age-sex standardised rate / 100,000, 2019



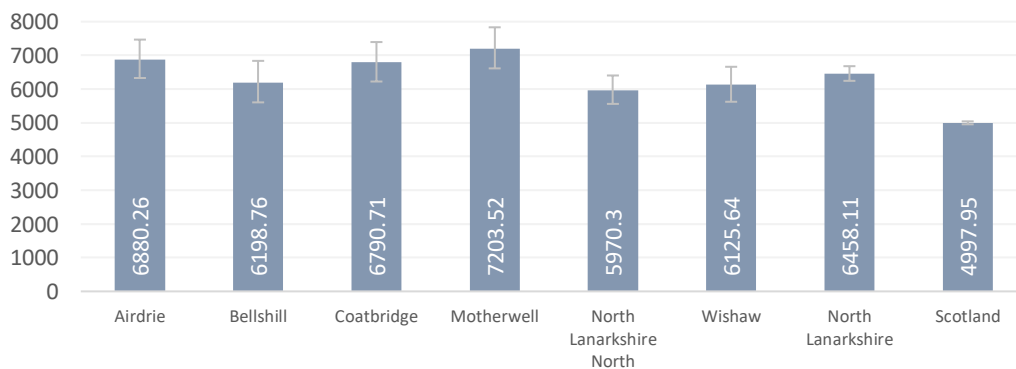
Emergency patient hospitalisations - Age-sex standardised rate per 100,000 – localities in NLHSCP



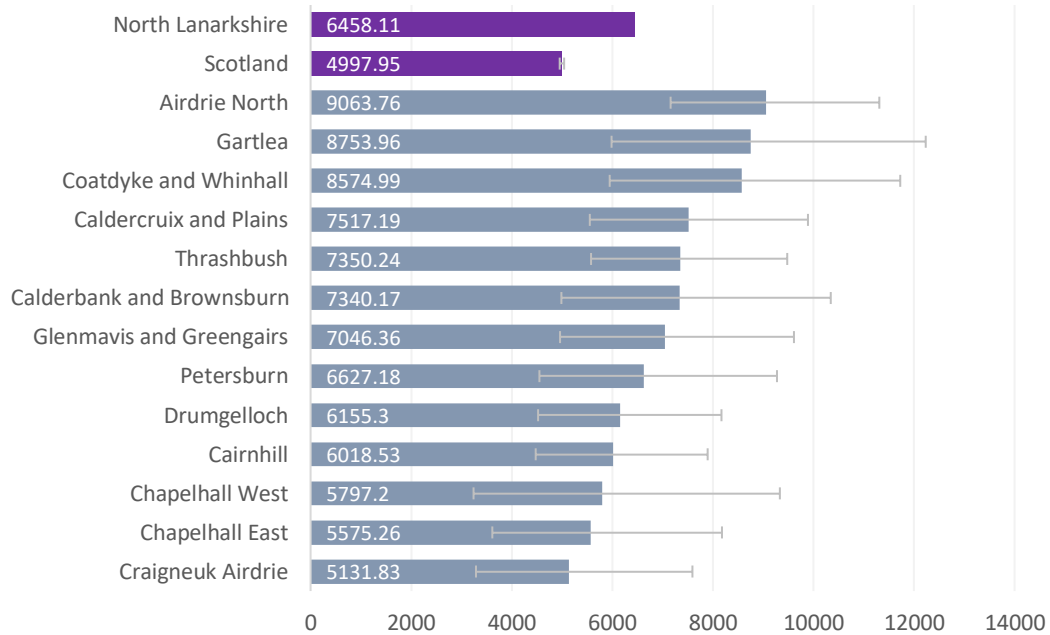
Emergency patient hospitalisations - Age-sex standardised rate per 100,000 – intermediate datazones in Airdrie



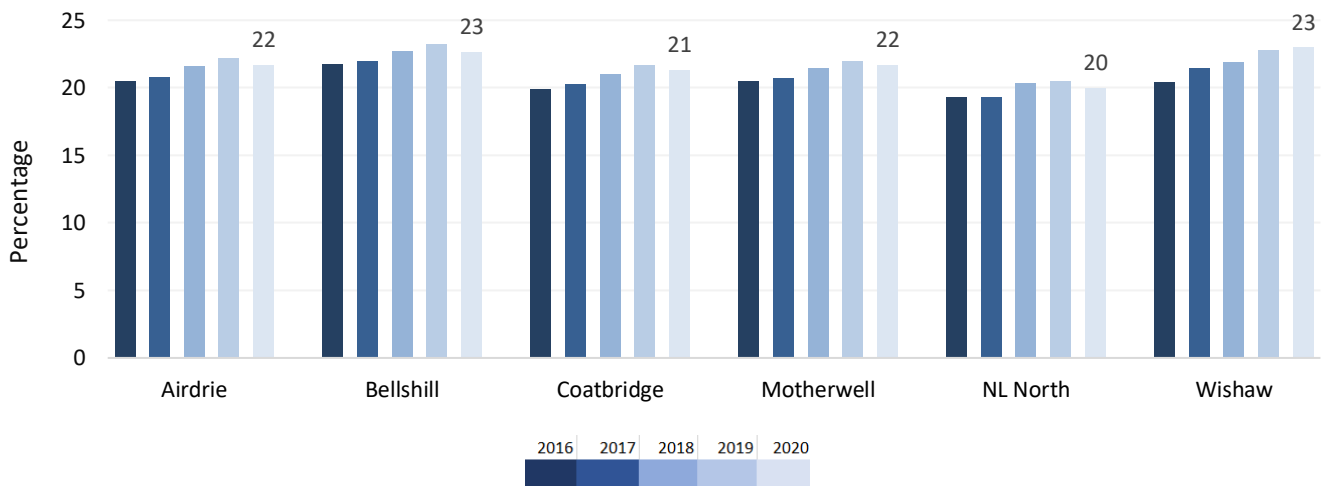
Patients (65+) with multiple emergency hospitalisations – localities in NL HSCP

Population prescribed drugs for anxiety/depression/psychosis (%) 2016 to 2020

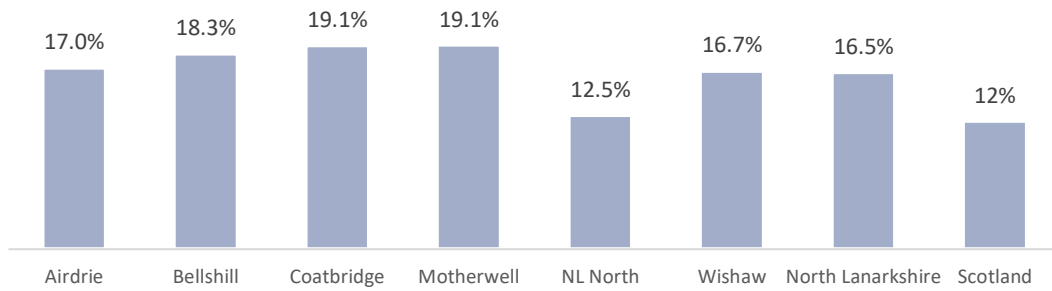

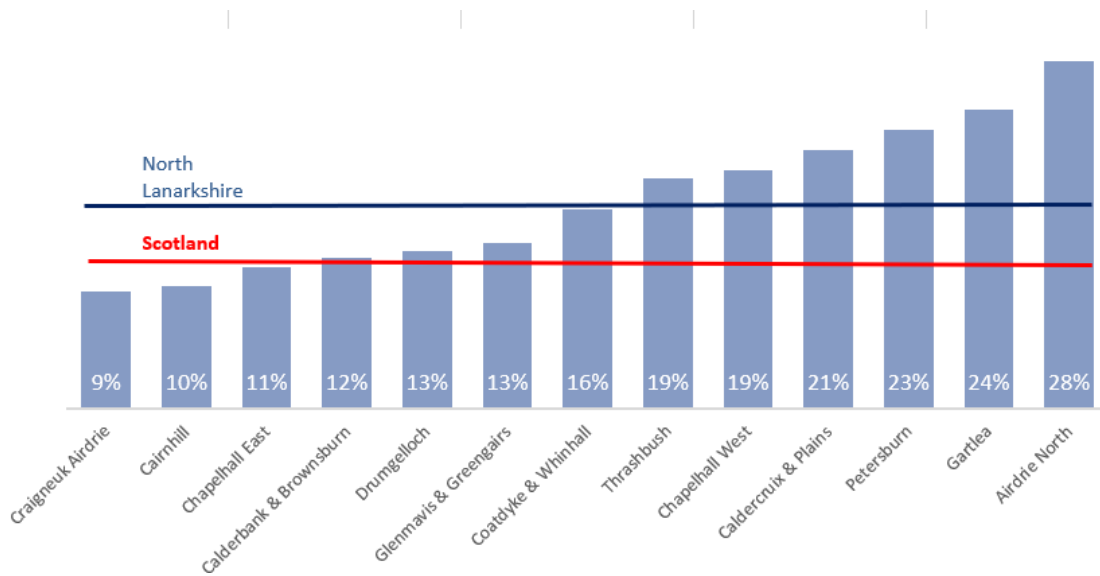

Pension Credits May 2022 Recipients as Percentage of 65+ population – localities in NL HSCP

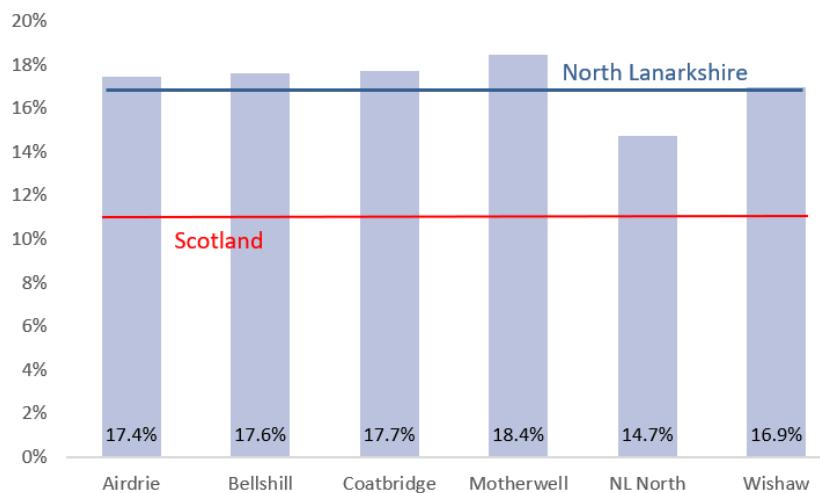


Pension Credits May 2022 Recipients as Percentage of 65+ population – intermediate datazones in Airdrie
