# B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, A89 Glasgow Road & A89 Coatbridge Road

#### Proposed Speed Limit Order 20\*\*

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, A89 Glasgow Road & A89 Coatbridge Road) (Speed Limit) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on \*\*\*, the \*\*\* day of \*\*\*, Two thousand and \*\*\*.

- 1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with subparagraph (2) below.
- 2. A twenty miles per hour speed limit will apply to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, only when the speed limit signs are activated.
- 3. Without prejudice to the provision of sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. The County of Lanark (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.2) Order, 1973 and The NLC A89 Coatbridge Road/A752 Langmuir Road/A752 Gartcosh Road, Bargeddie 30 MPH Speed Limit Order 2011 are hereby amended as specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.

From its junction with the A89 Coatbridge Road, northwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby.

#### **PART TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

## A89 Coatbridge Road & A89 Glasgow Road

From a point 18 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of Oakridge Road, eastwards to a point 80 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of Westbarr Drive, a distance of 232 metres or thereby.

## Oakridge Road, Bargeddie

From its junction with the A89 Coatbridge road, northwards for a distance of 65 metres or thereby.
