Proposed Speed Limit Reduction Order 20**

This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A752 and Townhead Road, Coatbridge) (Speed Limit Reduction) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on ***, the *** day of ***, Two thousand and ***.

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

SCHEDULE I

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

A752

To a point 165 metres or thereby, north of the junction with Townhead Road To a point 435 metres or thereby, south of the junction with Townhead Road

Townhead Road, Coatbridge

From the junction with A752 to a point 25 metres or thereby west of the junction with Lochview Road.
