Progress to date

North Lanarkshire Council and project architect BDP have facilitated three in-person public consultation events as part of the pre-Planning application process, taking on board the feedback from all members of the public who attended.

All comments gathered from these events were recorded within a Pre-Application Consultation report, which has now been submitted as part of the full Planning application for consideration by North Lanarkshire Council Planning Department.

Upcoming developments

Several trees at the proposed new road entrance will also be removed as part of the preparatory works, with the timber produced from the removal being retained for incorporating into the new landscaping.

We will also be carrying out physical identification of existing services over the coming weeks, which will involve some digging and scanning works to expose and record services locations across the site.
