## Housing (Scotland) Bill

Introduced to Parliament on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2024

#### **Two main elements**


- New Deal for Tenants
  - Capping rent increases and establishing long term rent controls
  - Strengthen eviction protections
  - New rights relating to home decoration and keeping pets
- Prevention of Homelessness
  - Extending support for people threatened with homelessness from 2 months to 6 months
  - Introduce 'ask and act' duties across social landlords and all public bodies
    - Key aim to share responsibility for ending homelessness and take proactive action
  - Provisions by social landlords to support tenants who are experiencing or at risk of domestic abuse





#### Current Housing Pressures and Market Drivers

- Cost of Living Crisis and inflationary costs
- Housing Affordability
  - Rising house prices
  - Mortgage interest rate hikes
- PRS drivers
  - Affordability for landlords
  - Increasing rents and evictions
  - Legislative requirements
  - Potential future reduction in PRS properties

- Rising waiting lists for social housing
  - Increase in Homelessness
  - Local Connection legislative change
- Wider policy and legislative changes

#### RDGS & Open Market Purchase Scheme

#### **RDGS**

- Want to live in NL
- Aged 16+ and in housing need
- Unable to raise the deposit
- Can meet monthly rental costs

#### **Open Market Purchase Scheme**

- Demand for type & size in area
- Combined cost of purchase & repairs is value for money
- Would give council complete or majority ownership
- Would meet needs of those with disabilities
- Purchase from private landlords in certain circumstances
