(Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) (Variation **) Order 20**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them to do so, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, and having complied with Part II of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council Airdrie Area (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) (Variation) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on **, the ** day of **, Two thousand and **
2. Upon the coming into effect of this Order, the Orders specified in the Schedule to this Order shall have effect, subject to amendments specified in that Schedule.

SCHEDULE

ORDERS TO BE AMENDED

The North Lanarkshire Council (Airdrie Area) (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as amended by the North Lanarkshire Council (Airdrie Area) (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) (Variation **) Order 20**

Delete Articles 3 to 47 in their entirety.

Add Article 3

Save as provided in Articles 9, 10, 11, 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or parking attendant, in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road, and during such times and days, as specified in Schedule III; (i) for a period longer than that specified in that Schedule, or (ii) if a period less than that specified in the Schedule has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in the relevant length of road. Each length of road which is specified in Schedule III to this Order is hereby designated as a parking place. The limits of each parking place designated in this Order shall be indicated on the carriageway as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Every vehicle left in any parking place designated in this Order shall so stand such that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place. Where the size of the vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a parking place or parking space if the extreme point of either the front, side or rear of the vehicle is no more than 300 millimetres outside the marked parking place or parking space.

Add Article 4

Save as provided in Articles 9, 10, 11, 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or parking attendant, in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedules IV, VI, VIII

Add Article 5

Save as provided in Articles, 9, 10, 11, 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road, and during such times and days, as specified in Schedules I, II, VII, XI, XII (i) for a period longer than that specified in that Schedule, or (ii) if a period less than that specified in the Schedule has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in the relevant length of road.

Add Article 6

Save as provided in Article 13, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or parking attendant, in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule V.

Add Article 7

- (a) Each area of road which is described in Schedules X to this Order is hereby designated as a parking place;
- (b) The parking places designated in Schedules X to this Order shall only be used for the leaving of disabled persons' vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's badge;
- (c) The limits of each parking place designated in this Order shall be indicated on the carriageway as prescribed by the Traffic Regulations and General Directions 2016;

- (d) Every vehicle left in any parking place designated in this Order shall so stand such that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place. Where the length of a vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a parking place if: (i) the extreme point of either the front or rear of the vehicle is no more than 300 millimetres outside the marked disabled persons' parking place, and (ii) the vehicle, or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining disabled persons' parking place;
- (e) A police officer in uniform, parking attendant or any person duly authorised by the Council, may, in the case of an emergency, instruct the owner/driver to move the vehicle to a safer place;
- (f) Any parking attendant or person duly authorised by the Council may suspend or reserve the use of a parking place, or any part thereof, whenever and for such period as they may consider reasonable;
- (g) A police officer in uniform, parking attendant or any person duly authorised by the Council, may suspend, for not longer than twenty four hours, the use of parking place or part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

Add Article 8

Save as provided in Articles 9, 10, 11, 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or parking attendant, in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a goods vehicle, to wait or stop in any of the lengths of road, and during such times and days, as specified in Schedule IX.

Add Article 9

Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedules I, II, III, VI, VII, VIII, XI, XII while the vehicle is in actual use for the purposes of loading goods onto or unloading goods from the vehicle at premises adjacent to the length of road, during such hours and on such days as are specified and permitted in that Schedule.

Add Article 10

Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 of this Order shall apply to: (a) any vehicle while being used for fire and rescue, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of any restriction in these articles would likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for such purposes; (b) any vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, while being used in the service of the Council in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other length of road; (c) any public service vehicle while waiting at any authorised stopping place; (d) any vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other length of road, while being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying erection, alteration, removal or repair in or near the road of any sewer or main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any apparatus comprised in any electronic communications network; (e) any liveried vehicle in the service of, or employed by, a universal service provider and in actual use in a length of road while postal packets: (i) addressed to premises adjacent to the length of road are being unloaded from the vehicle or, having being unloaded, are being delivered to those premises, or (ii) are being collected from postal boxes or premises adjacent to the length of road for loading on to the vehicle or are being so loaded, and (f) any security vehicle in actual use in a length of road while currency or other valuables: (i) are being unloaded from the vehicle for delivery to premises adjacent to the length of road or, having been unloaded, are being so delivered or (ii) are being collected from premises adjacent to the length of road for loading on to the vehicle or, having been collected, are being so loaded.

Add Article 11

Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of lengths of road specified in Schedules I, II, III, IV, VI, VII, VIII, XI, XII for as long as may be necessary: (a) to enable a person to board or alight a vehicle; (b) if the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from any residential or commercial premises adjacent to the road in question and (c) if the vehicle is in actual use in connection with a funeral undertaking.

Add Article 12

Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle waiting in any lengths of road specified in Schedules I, II, III, VI, VII, VIII, X, XII, XII during such times and days when loading is permitted, the vehicle is not causing an obstruction and on which is displayed, in the relevant position, a valid disabled persons' badge,.

Add Article 13

Nothing in Article 6 shall apply to:-

- (a) any vehicle where the driver: (i) is required by law to stop, (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident, (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances out with the driver's control and it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to be driven or moved to a place not on the length of road;
- (b) any vehicle while being used for fire and rescue, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of any restriction in these articles would likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for such purposes;
- (c) any vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, while being use in the service of the Council in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other length of road;
- (d) any vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other length of road, while being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying erection, alteration, removal or repair in or near the road of any sewer or main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any apparatus comprised in any electronic communications network.

Add Article 14

If a vehicle is left on any of the roads specified in the Schedules without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A Penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by the appropriate legislation may then be issued by a parking attendant in accordance with the requirements of the legislation or any subsequent applicable legislation or the vehicle may be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such penalty charge. Where a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a vehicle no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, a parking attendant in uniform, or some other person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the notice from the vehicle, a parking attendant in uniform, or some other person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorise to do so by the owner of the vehicle.

From a point 80 metres southeast of the extended southeast kerbline of Deedes Street south eastwards for a distance of 110metres (southwest side)
