**The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Stirling Road and B803 Greengairs Road,
Airdrie) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2025**

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Above Order

It is considered necessary to make the above Order to reduce the speed limit identified in the interests of road safety following correspondence from the public and elected members, traffic surveys and a review of accident histories, and to facilitate the future introduction of the East Airdrie Link Road.

REPORT FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDER

Location: A73 Stirling Road and B803 Greengairs Road, Airdrie

Proposal: Introduce a new speed limit reduction and revoke an existing Order.

1. The proposed Order will increase the extents of the existing 40mph speed limit on A73 Stirling Road and introduce a new 40mph speed limit on a length of B803 Greengairs Road to improve road safety.
2. Police Scotland, the Scottish Ambulance Service, the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, The Road Haulage Association Limited, The Freight Transport Association Limited, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport, Local Councillors, as well as other organisations and residents directly affected have all been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.
3. The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Stirling Road, Stand, Airdrie) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004 will be revoked by this Order.
4. I therefore recommend that North Lanarkshire Council advertise its intention to introduce the proposed speed limit reduction and revoke The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Stirling Road, Stand, Airdrie) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004 as described in the attached schedules.
