BAM Construction are working in partnership with Hub South West Scotland and North Lanarkshire Council to provide this project.




Progress to Date

The external envelope of the building is progressing well, with the roof and window works now substantially complete. The facing brick to several elevations is now complete and progressing well around the remainder of the build.

The internal fit out is also well underway. Drylining, mechanical and electrical installations, decoration and ceiling works are progressing throughout the building.

Upcoming Developments

Roadworks - there will be offsite roadworks on **Woodneuk Avenue** starting **2nd February 2026** for 6 weeks, this will involve the section of road parallel to the site (highlighted below) being reduced to one lane with traffic management in place to control traffic.
