Applicant: Glenmavis Community Group

Are requesting to take ownership of Glenmavis Community Centre, this includes the attached car park to the front of the centre.

The building would be utilised as a community centre, reopened to former lets prior to closure of the site and to new groups who require a space. There would be a lease/ hiring agreement with Army Cadet Force who will also be utilising the building. The applicant proposes to reintroduce afternoon teas for senior citizens and would welcome bookings from exercise/ martial arts groups. The applicant also proposes applying for £100,000 of funding to upgrade the car park and building.
