Progress to Date

Construction of the extension education facilities are well under way with the roofs complete. Partitions and services being installed internally.

Small refurb works have already been completed and handed over within the existing school with works concentrated throughout the Easter break.

Upcoming Developments

We will be completing all cladding, brickwork and curtain walling soon and starting the external landscaping works completing areas around the outside of the building.

In the coming weeks we will have the classroom walls formed and will be starting with the ceilings and underfloor heating throughout the extension, as well as refurbishment works to the adjoining areas of the existing school.

Pupils at Chryston High School will benefit from a new construction shed.

As part of the Community Benefits Programme, construction students will gain hands-on experience by working alongside a range of subcontractors during the installation of their new external construction space. This practical involvement will support the development of new skills and enhance learning within the construction class.
