Progress to Date

Construction of the extension education facilities are progressing well with scaffolds cleared in most areas and landscaping works started externally. Mechanical and electrical services installed along with rooms formed and decoration started.

Small refurb works have already been completed and handed over within the existing school.

An external constructions skills classroom has been built behind the existing school for their practical education.

Upcoming Developments

We will be continuing hard and soft landscaping works around the building.

In the coming weeks all internal walls to classrooms, underfloor heating throughout the extension and installation of doors and ceilings will be completed. Decorating will start.

We have various refurbishment works being carried out throughout the existing school during the summer along with service works from the new extension to the existing building, including refurbishment and preparation of the section where the buildings link. While these works are taking place the school and Cultural Centre will be closed from 26 June to 10 August.
