The applicant proposes to purchase this piece of land to protect it's current use for the local community and develop it into an enhanced greenspace for the Newmains community. The proposal includes community growing areas, improvement to the orchard, outdoor play and fitness activities and facilities, learning features, seating and social spaces. The applicant's proposal aims to improve health, wellbeing, environmental sustainability and community involvement.
