Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Above Order

It is considered necessary to make the above Order to improve the safety, maintain free flow of traffic, and maintain reasonable access to premises.

REPORT FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDER

Location: Various Streets, Gartcosh

Proposal: Introduce Various Traffic Restrictions

1. The proposed Order will extend the current Auldyards Road Clearway.
2. Introduce areas of No waiting at any time on various areas of Craignethan Drive, Auldyards Road (Woodneuk Avenue), Mowbray Avenue, Woodneuk Terrace, Johnston Road, Lochside, Blades Court and Whittington Place.
3. Introduce areas of limited waiting on Craignethan Drive.
4. Formalise and relocate the Taxi Rank at the train station.
5. Introduce limited waiting on Woodneuk Terrace
6. All measures are for road safety reasons and in order to maintain free flow of traffic and reasonable access to premises related to concerns of parking near the Scottish Crime Campus and railway station, as the building of a new Community Hub off Auldyards Road (Woodneuk Avenue).
7. It also incorporates waiting restrictions originally introduced by the North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets Gartcosh and Glenboig) (Waiting Restriction) Order 2020, which would be revoked.
8. Police Scotland, the Scottish Ambulance Service, the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, The Road Haulage Association Limited, The Freight Transport Association Limited, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport, Local Councillors, have all been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.
9. I therefore recommend that North Lanarkshire Council advertise its intention to introduce the proposed traffic restrictions as described in the attached schedules
