**Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make
The Above Order**

It is considered necessary to make the above Order to amend the existing extents of the part time 20mph speed limit, to improve road safety, and to provide safe access to the new community hub.

REPORT FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDER

Location: A89 Coatbridge Road and Glasgow Road, Bargeddie
Oakridge Road, Bargeddie

Proposal: Amend Schedule within existing Order and revoke existing Order

1. The proposed amendment is intended to amend a schedule within the existing order to extend the extents of the speed limit on sections of the above roads, to improve road safety.
2. Police Scotland, the Scottish Ambulance Service, the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, The Road Haulage Association Limited, The Freight Transport Association Limited, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport, Local Councillors, as well as other organisations have all been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.
3. The North Lanarkshire Council (B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, A89 Glasgow Road and A89 Coatbridge Road) (Speed Limit) Order 2024 will be amended by this Order.
4. The North Lanarkshire Council (Drumpark School, A89 Coatbridge Road, Glasgow Road, Bargeddie) (20mph speed limit) Order 2007 will be revoked by this Order.
5. I therefore recommend that North Lanarkshire Council advertise its intention to amend the existing order in the lengths of roads as described in the attached schedule.
